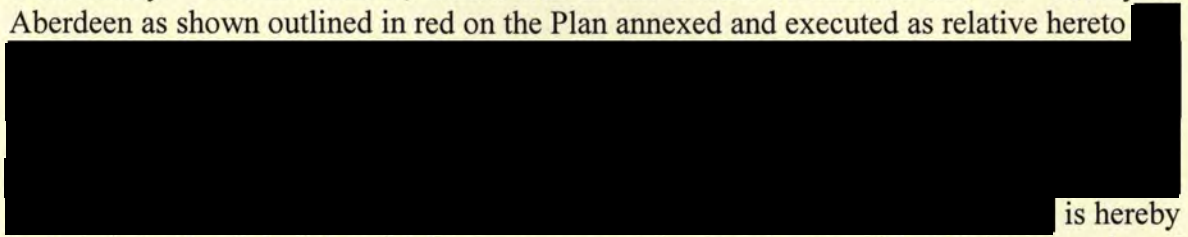


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Castle of Hallforest, comprises the remains of the Castle of Hallforest, an early towerhouse constructed in the 14th century. The monument stands in fairly level farmland with a prominent stony bank about 10m to the N. The area to be scheduled includes the tower and area surrounding the castle where remains associated with its construction and use could be expected to survive. This includes the stony bank to the N. The area is four-sided and has maximum dimensions of 70m NW-SE and 66m transversely. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kintore and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

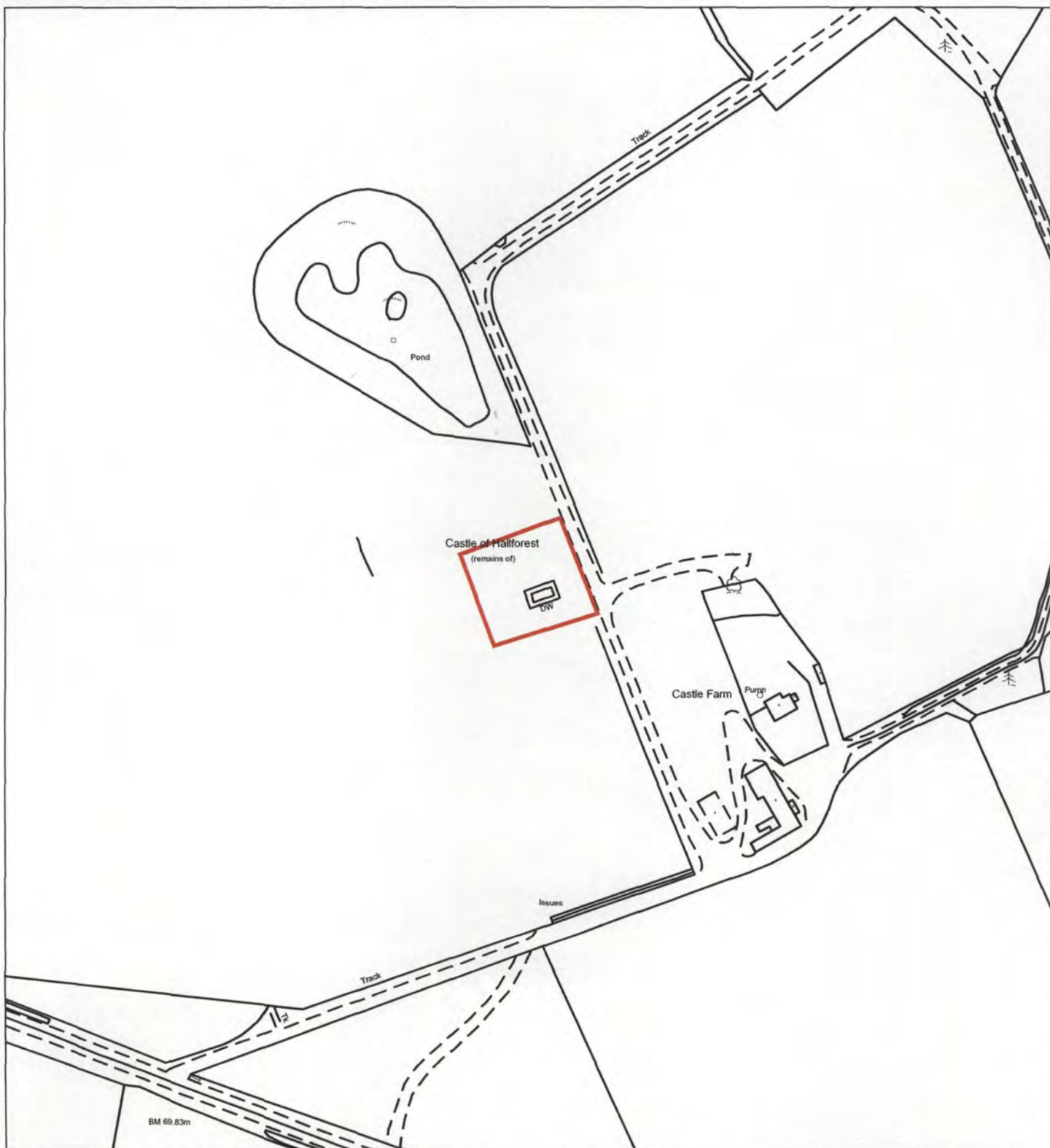

Scheduled Area



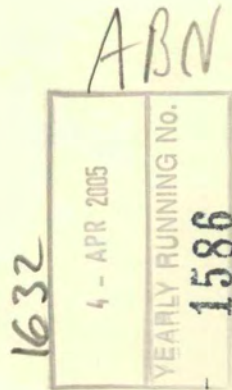
