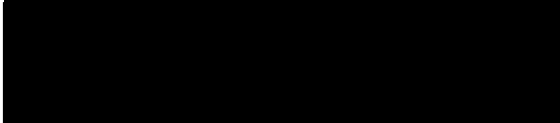

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.



the owner of the Monument known as Coull Castle contained within an irregular area of ground measuring 350 feet at its greatest length from West-North-West to East-South-East and 260 feet at its greatest width from North-North-East to South-South-West, the North-Eastmost corner of said area being situated 100 yards North-East of Tarland Burn at its nearest point, 200 yards South-South-East of the South-Eastmost gable of the Church at Coull and 934 yards North-East by North of Bench Mark 442.0 on the North-Westmost gable of the main buildings of Mill of Gellan,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the farm and lands of Coull

situated in the Parish of Coull and County of Aberdeen.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

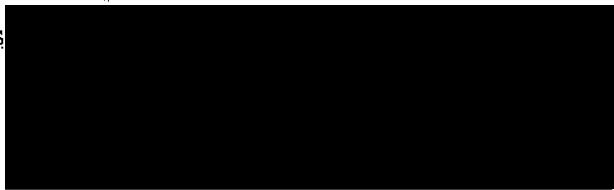

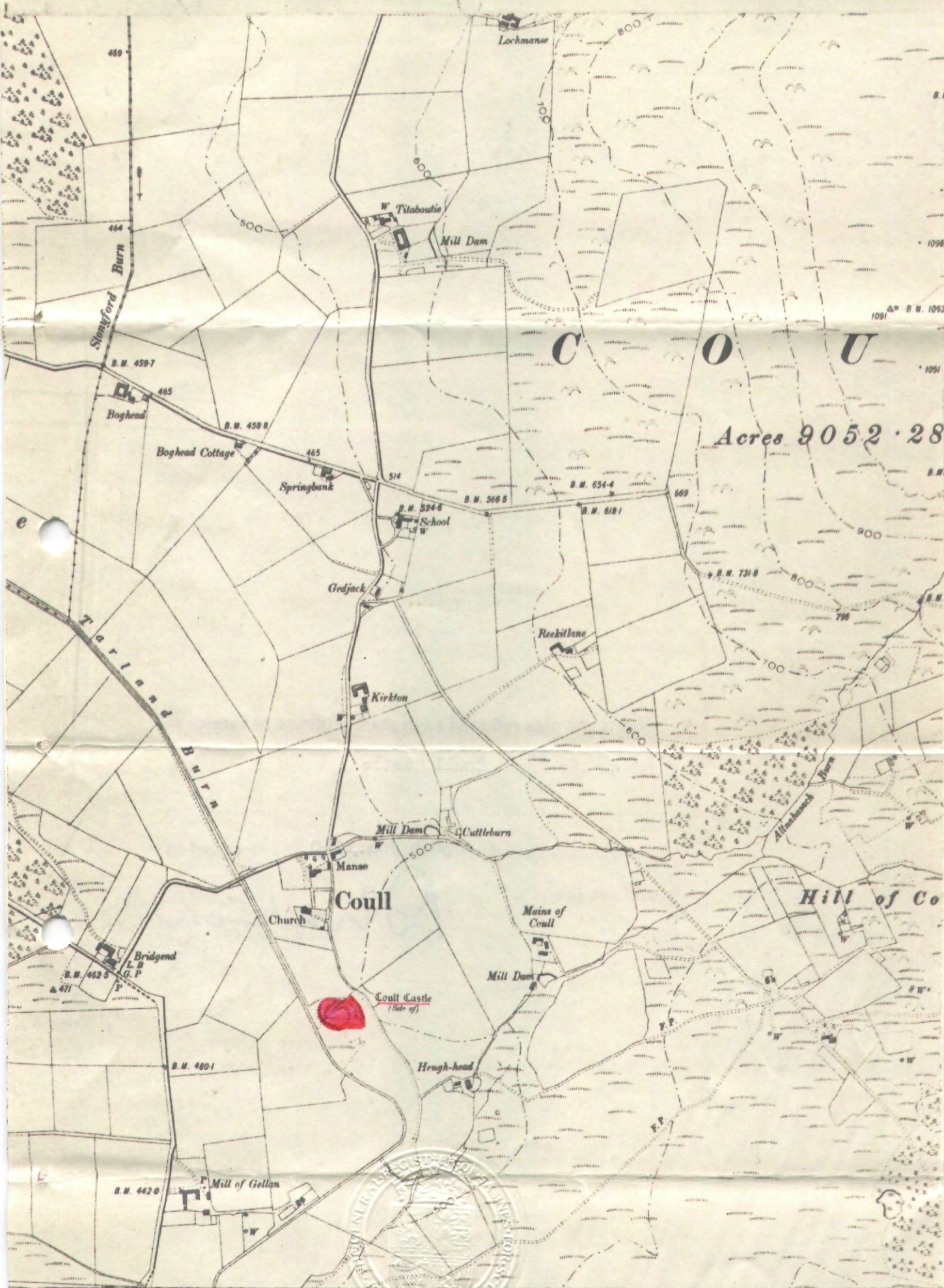

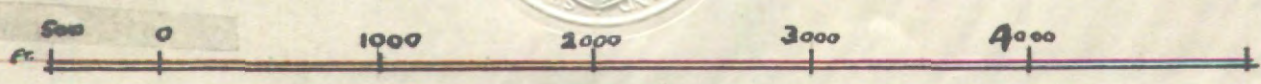
