The monument known as Inverallochy Castle, comprises the remains of Inverallochy Castle, a massive but ruinous castle situated on an area of flat coastal plain. The area to be scheduled includes the courtyard and area surrounding the castle where associated archaeology could be expected to survive. This includes an area of land to the N and W which appears to represent an outer courtyard. The area is irregular and has maximum dimensions of 60m NNE-SSW by 55m WNW-ESE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rathen and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

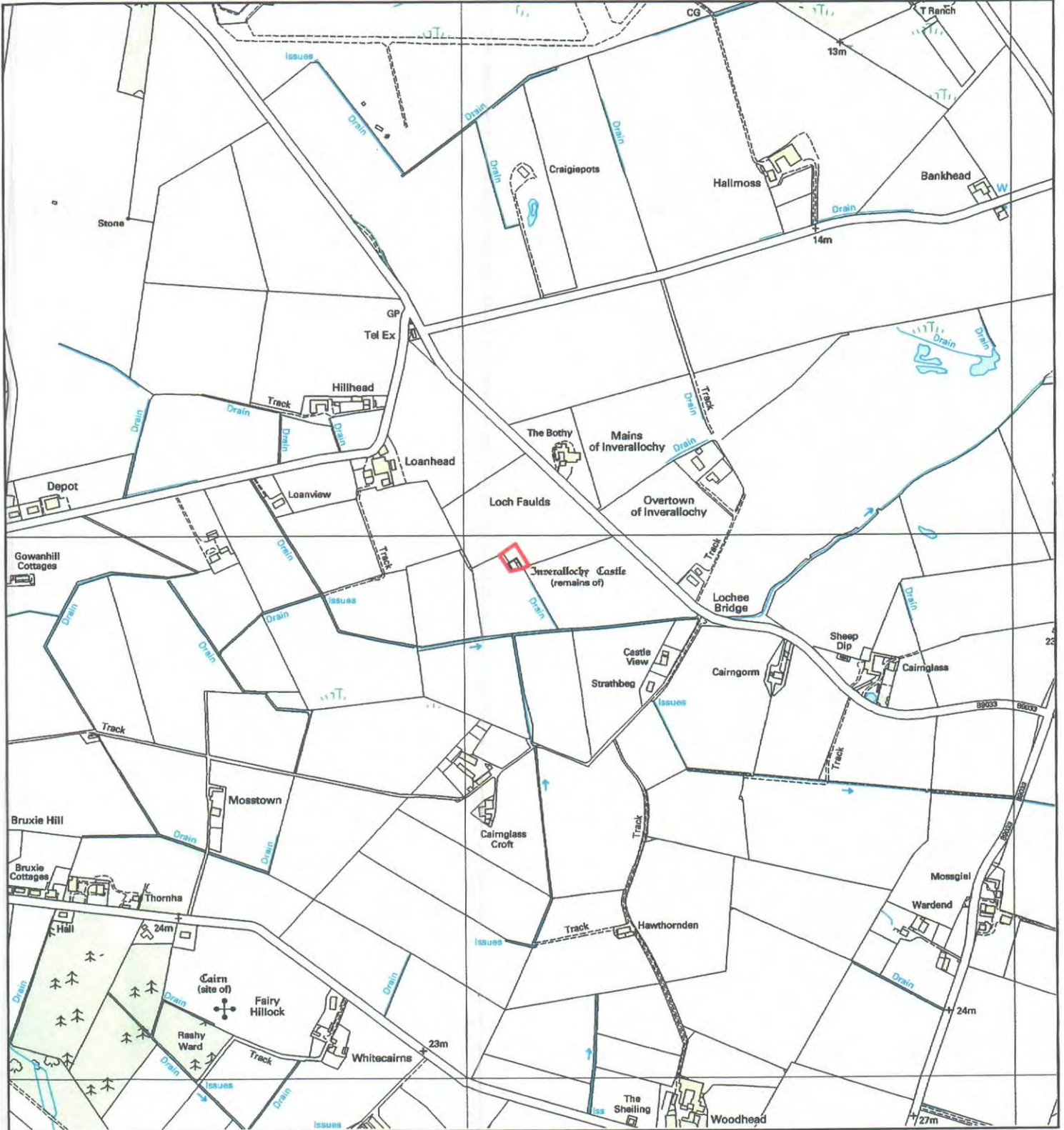

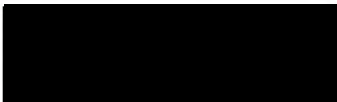
