owners of monument known as Castle of Blairfindy which is 23yds north of Castletown of Blairfindy and is an L-plan tower house with wing slightly projected, the other sides of which are defended with round turrets corbelled out on the angles. The main block measures 53ft by 36ft, the wing 26ft 6ins by 16ft. The Monument is marked red on the annexed map and is part of the Gordon-Richmond Estates

situated in the Parish of Inveraven and County of Banff.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Scottish Royal Parks and Ancient Monuments) Order, 1969, the Secretary of State hereby gives notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

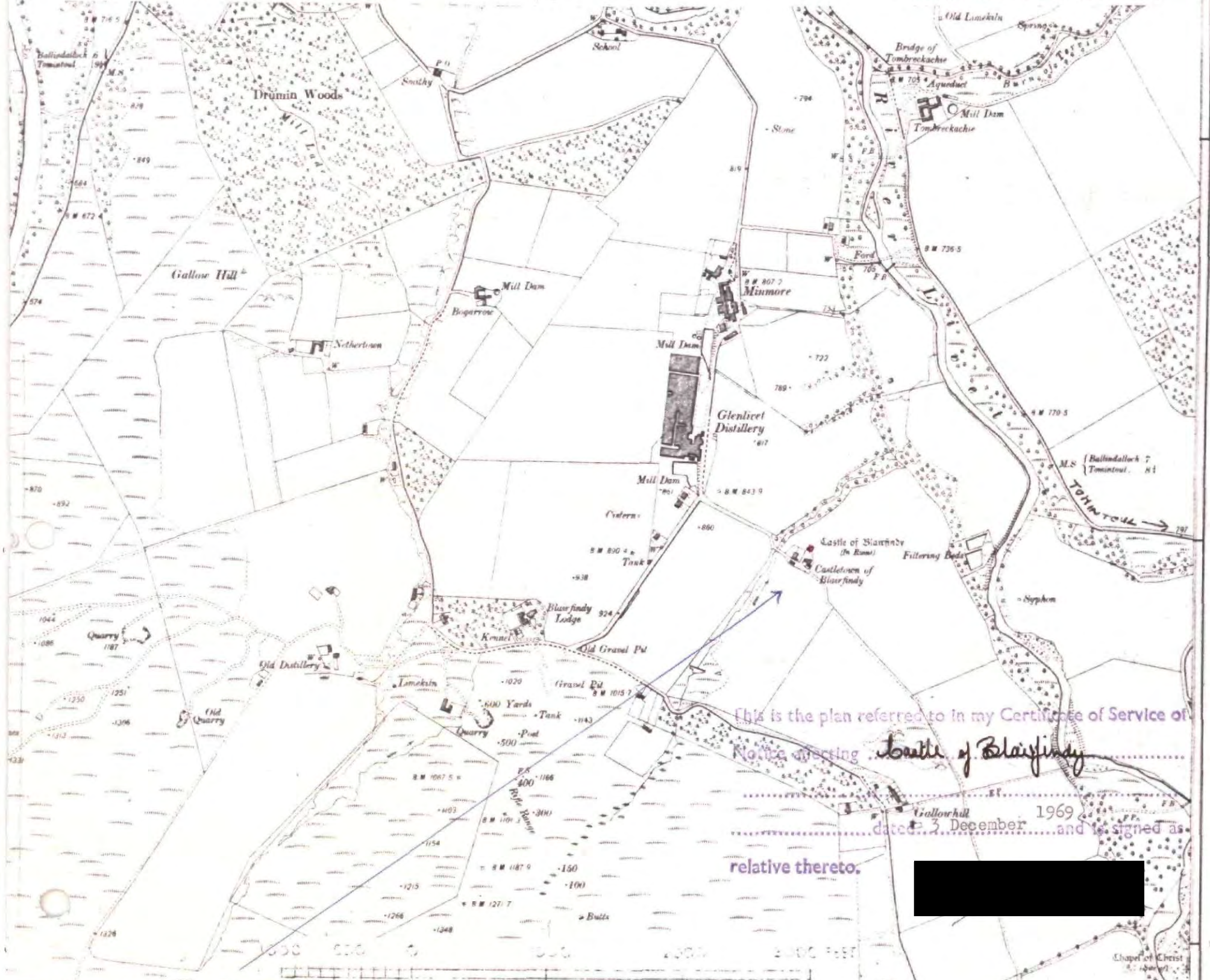
