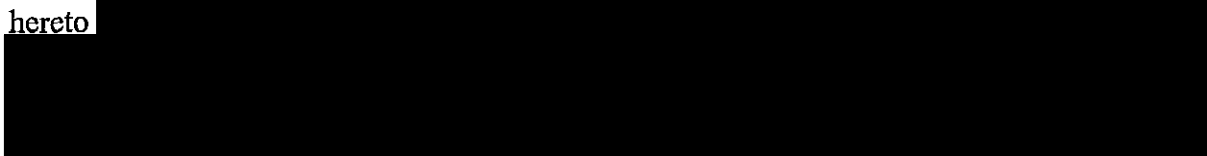

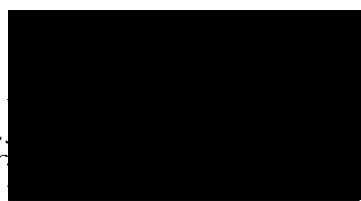

The monument known as Gourdie, stone circle 850m S of comprises the remains of a stone circle of prehistoric date. The area to be scheduled encompasses the stone circle and an area around it in which traces of associated activity may be expected to survive. It is circular with a diameter of 40m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dundee and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

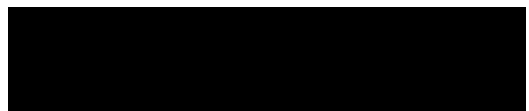

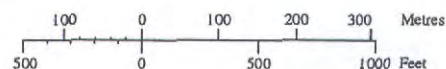
Gourdie, stone circle 850m S of
