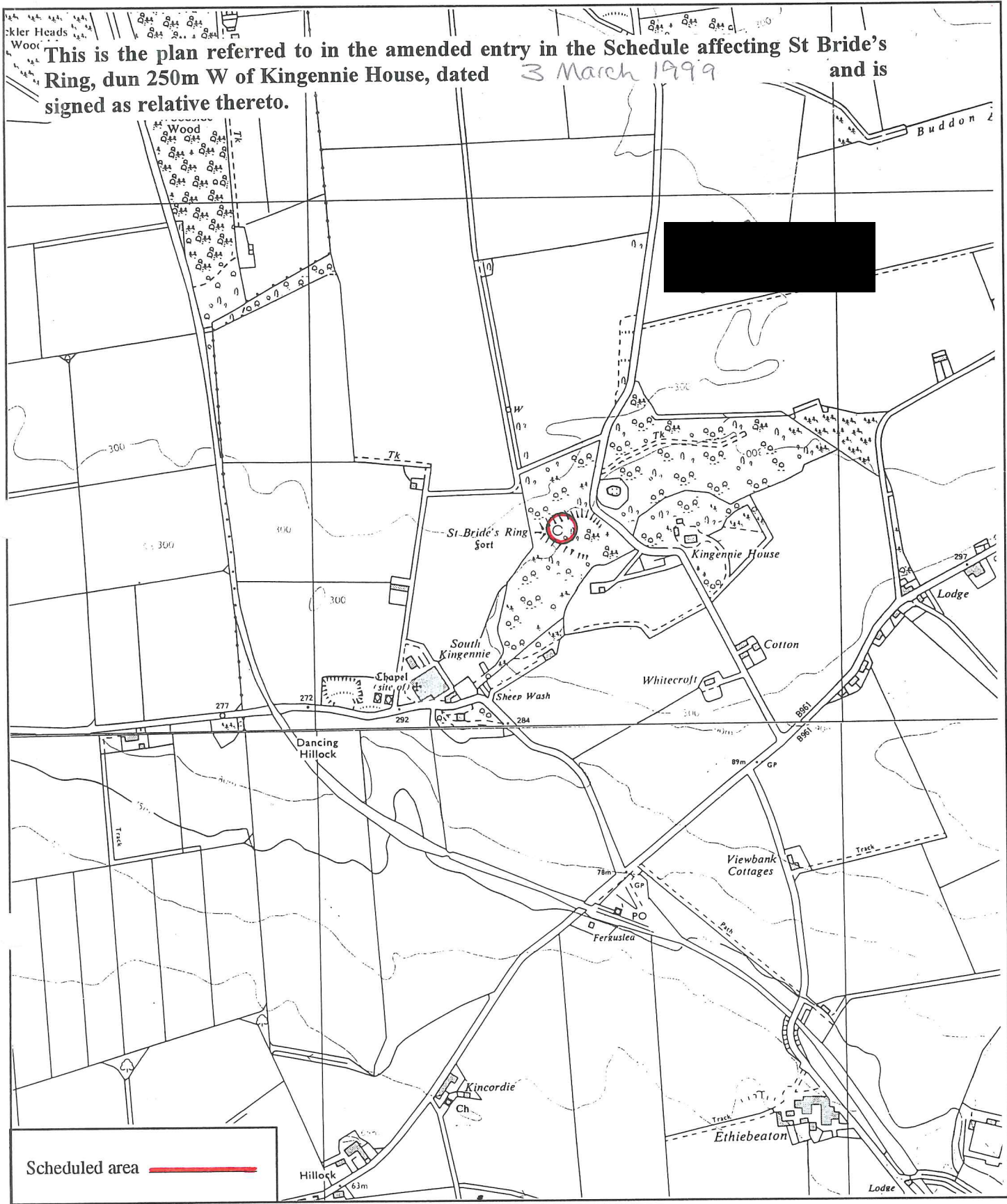

the owners of the Monument known as Saint Bride's Rings contained within a circular area of ground measuring 64 feet in diameter, the northmost point of said area being situated 250 feet west-south-west of the road running northwards past Kingennie House at its nearest point, 600 feet south-west by south of the junction of the west side of said road with the south-east side of the road running in a general north-east direction from Kingennie Farm and 1180 feet north-east by north of the northmost corner of the farm steading buildings at said Farm,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.


