the owner of the Monument known as Castle Hillock contained within an oval area of ground bounded on the south-south-west by the public road from Edzell to Bridgend and measuring 450 ft. at its maximum length from east-south-east to west-north-west and 250 ft. at its maximum width from north-north-east to south-south-west the southeastmost point of said area being situated on the north margin of said road 600 ft. north-north-east of the West Water at its nearest point and 2,100 ft. southwest by west of the junction of the north side of said road with the southwest side of the Private Road serving Mains of Edzell

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and Barony of Panmure and others

situated in the Parish of Edzell and
County of Angus.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

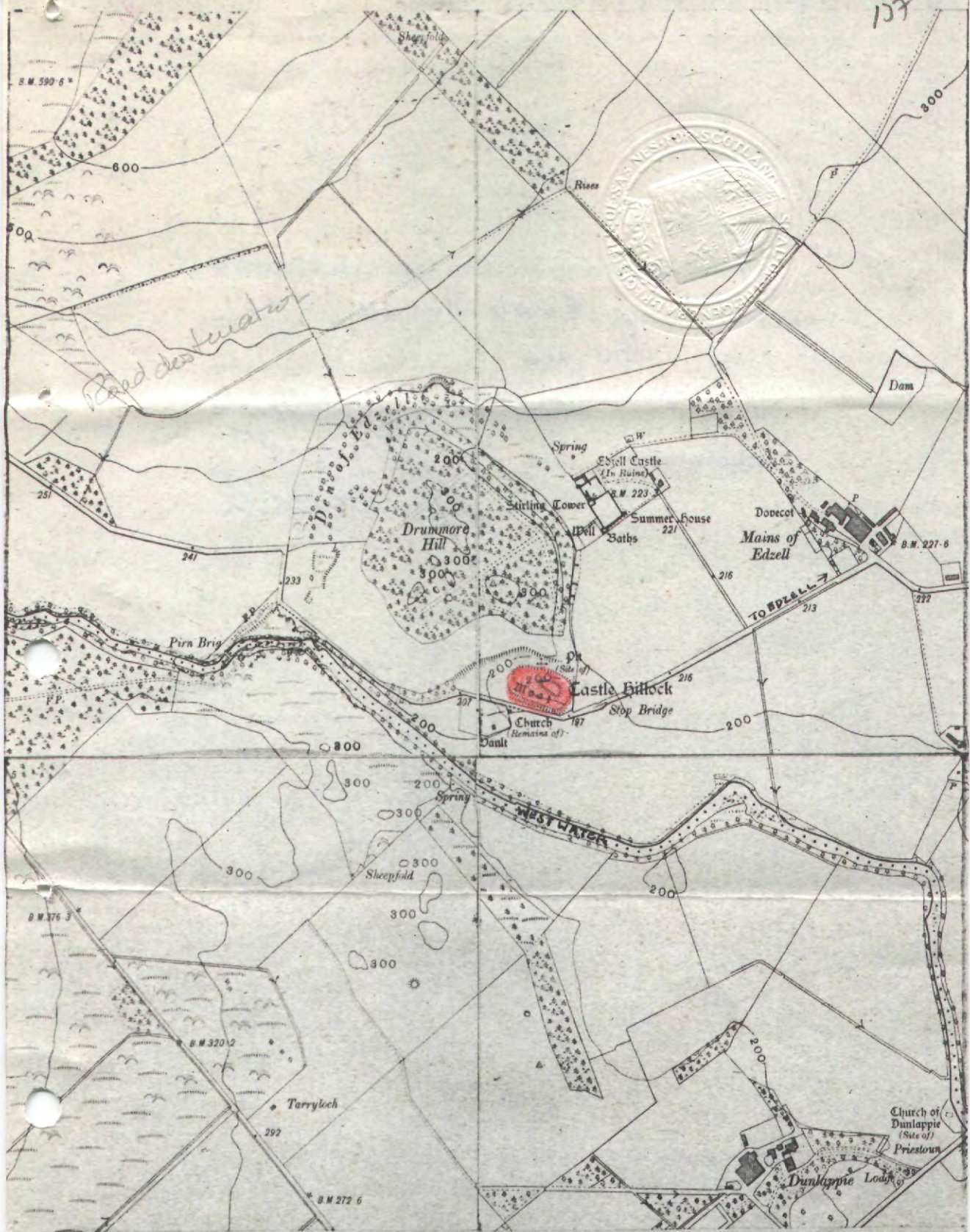
