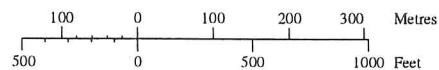
Denoon Law, fort

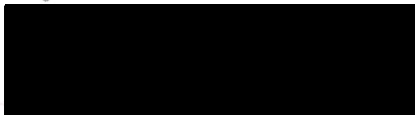
