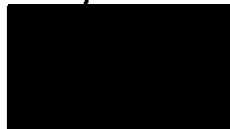
the owners of part of the monument known as the Roman Camp contained within an area of ground at Whig Street Wood bounded on the north-west partly by parts of two fields lying between said Wood and the Muir of Lour and partly by parts of two fields lying between said Wood and the railway between Dundee and Forfar to the north of Rosekinghall along which together it extends 920 yards; on the south-east by other parts of the southmost of said two last mentioned fields along which it extends 30 yards; again on the north-east by other parts of said last mentioned field along which it extends 80 yards; again on the south-east partly by other parts of said last mentioned field, partly by the solum of the public road between Arbroath and Inverquhar and partly by parts of a field lying on the south side of said road to the east of Woodside Cottage along which together it extends 130 yards; on the south-west partly by other parts of said last mentioned field and partly by part of the garden ground of Woodside Cottage along which together it extends 70 yards; again on the south-east partly by other parts of said garden ground, partly by parts of said Wood and partly by parts of a field lying to the south of said Wood along which together it extends 290 yards; again on the south-west partly by other parts of said last mentioned field, partly by other parts of the westmost of the two first mentioned fields lying to the north of said Wood along which together it extends 870 yards and on the north-west by other parts of said last mentioned field along which it extends 430 yards being the subjects indicated in green, brown or blue colour on the annexed plan whereof the portion belonging to [redacted] is the north-west portion being the portion coloured green on said plan and being part of the property known as the Estate of Pourie-Fothringham, [redacted]

[redacted] is the south-east portion shown coloured brown on said plan and forming part of the subjects known as the Lands and Barony of Kirkbuddo in the Parish of Inverarity and County of Angus and (3) [redacted] is that portion to the south of said road coloured blue on said plan being part of the property known as Woodside Cottage in the Parish of Inverarity and County of Angus but excepting therefrom the solum of said cottage.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
