PLAN IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

[REDACTED] for any interest he may have as owner or otherwise of the Monuments known as the three standing stones and cist contained within an oval area measuring 70 yards at its greatest length from north-east to south-west and 40 yards at its greatest width from south-east to north-west, the south-westmost point of said area being 210 yards east-south-east of the Campbeltown Tarbert road at its nearest point, 400 yards north-east by east of the eastmost gable of Ballochroy and 300 yards north of the Ballochroy Burn at its nearest point, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Lands of Carnmore, Tayinloan, situated in the Parish of Kilcalmonell and County of Argyll.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

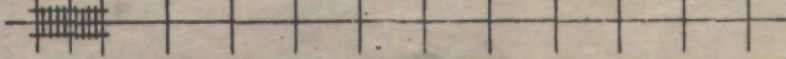

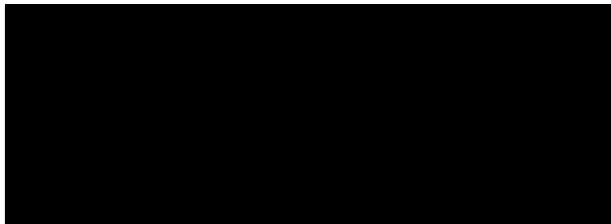

BALLOCHROY.

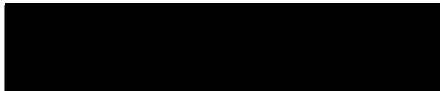


