IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

[REDACTED] the owner of the Monument known as Dun Mhuirich (Fort) contained within an irregular area of ground situated on the west bank of Linne Mhuirich having a maximum length from north east to south west of 80 yards and a maximum breadth from north west to south east of 60 yards the north eastmost point of said area being situated 50 yards west of the High Water Mark at its nearest point on the west shore of Linne Mhuirich, 80 yards east south east of the public road from Lochgilphead along the west side of Loch Sween at its nearest point and 230 yards north east of Bench Mark 32.0 on the east side of said public road

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and estate of Tayvallich

situated in the Parish of North Knapdale and
County of Argyll.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

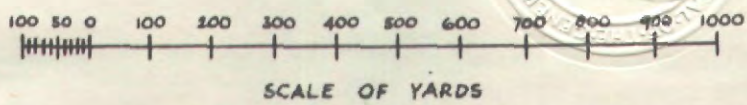

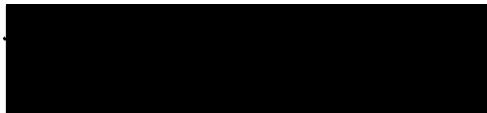
