The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Kilchenzie Church and tombstones, dated 13 September and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Argyll on 23 October both in the year 1972 and now to be known as Kilchenzie Church and burial ground is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 35m N-S and 55m E-W as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto. All lairs where burial rights still exist are excluded from the scheduling.
