IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

the owner of the Monument known as Fairlie Castle contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring 45 feet 6 inches on each of its north and south sides and 29 feet on each of its east and west sides, the south-westmost corner of said area being situated 20 yards north-west of the Fairlie Burn at its nearest point, 130 yards north-east of Bench Mark 134.4 on the north side of the road running eastwards from Fairlie Village along the north or right bank of said Burn and 370 yards north of the Southannan Burn at its nearest point,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Estate of Kelburn,

situated in the Parish of Largs, and County of Ayr.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

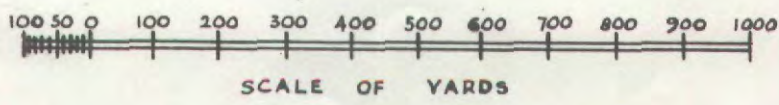
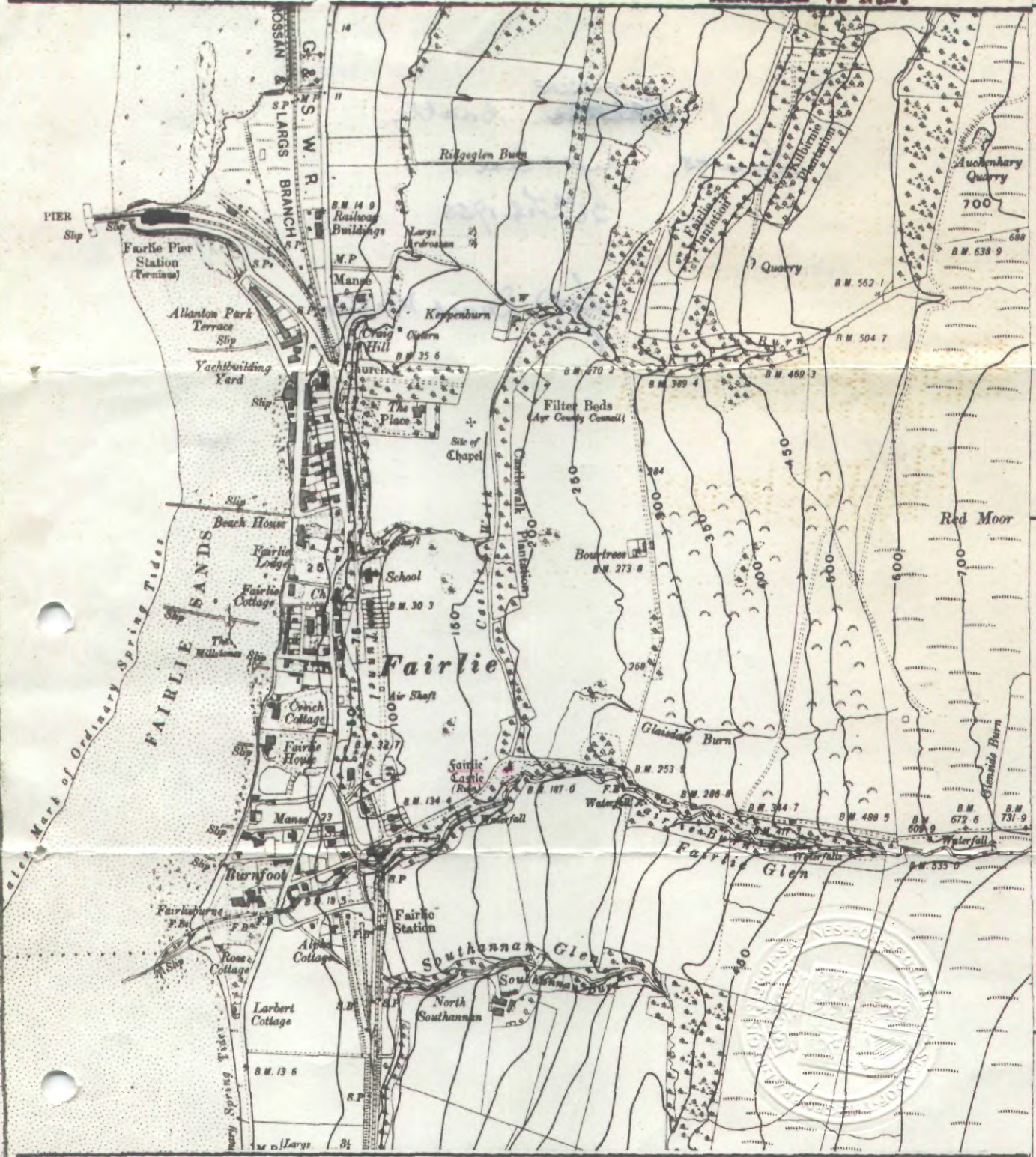
