the owner of the Monument known as Glengarnock Castle (in ruins) lying within an irregular area of ground on the east or left bank of the River Garnock on a bend of the River to the north-west of Garrat's Linn, said area of ground being bounded on the north, south and west by said River and measuring from its northmost corner to its south-eastmost corner 80 yards in a south-south-east direction, the northmost corner being 385 yards south-west of Birkhill and 520 yards north-west by west of the westmost gable of Blackburn

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Farm of Plan

situated in the Parish of Kilbirnie and
County of Ayr.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

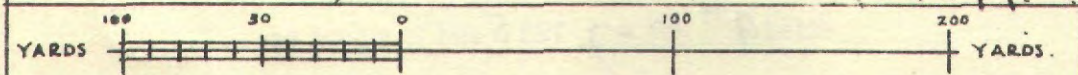
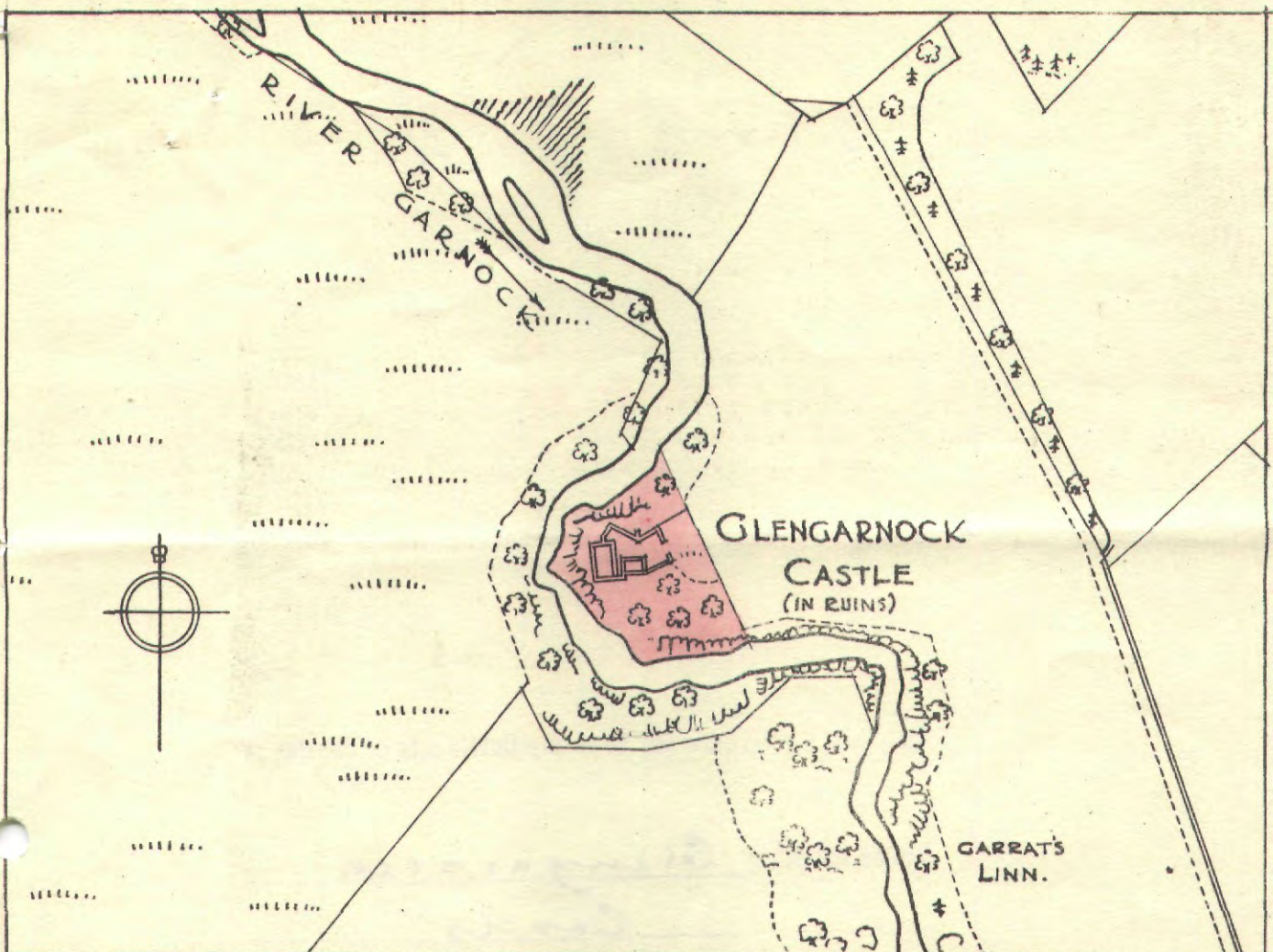

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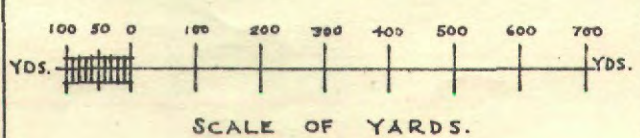
