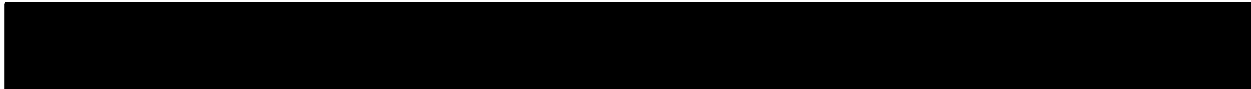

the owner of the Monument known as Knockdolian Castle (in ruins) contained within a rectangular area of ground measuring 35 feet on each of its north east and south west sides and 25 feet on each of its north west and south east sides, the southmost point of said area being situated 40 yards west north west of the River Stinchar at its nearest point, 120 yards east north east of the public road from Ballantrae to Daljarrock at its nearest point and 240 yards east south east of the south end of West Knockdolian Bridge,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and Barony of Knockdolian

situated in the Parish of Colmonell and County of Ayr.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

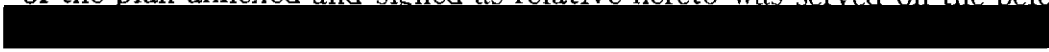

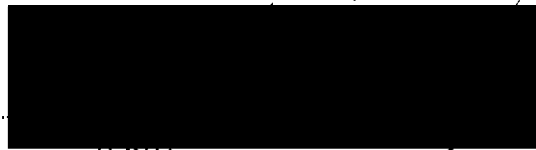


