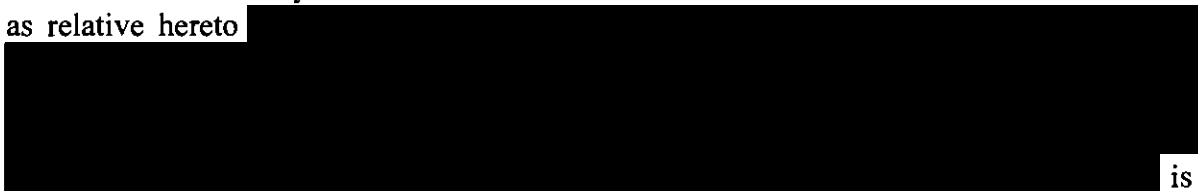

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

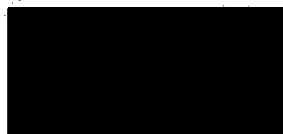
The monument known as Longman Cairn, long barrow, Longman Hill, comprises a well-preserved long earthen burial mound of the early Neolithic period. The area to be scheduled is rectangular and measures 90m NNE to SSW by 45m transversely, to include the visible remains of the mound and an area around in which features associated with the construction and use of the mound are likely to survive. The area of the abandoned quarry is included as it is necessary for the support of the monument. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Gamrie and the County of Banff as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

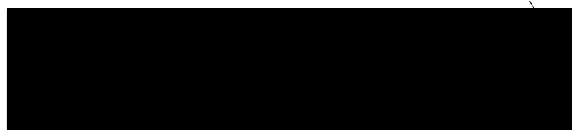
