The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Whitestones House, three symbol stones SW of (Tillytarmont 2, 3 and 4), dated 13 May and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Banff on 26 May both in the year 1965 [725.235] is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the monument to be scheduled as including the three symbol stones and a circular area with a radius of 2m centred on each of them in the position indicated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

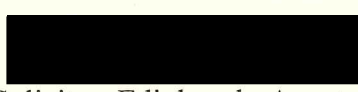

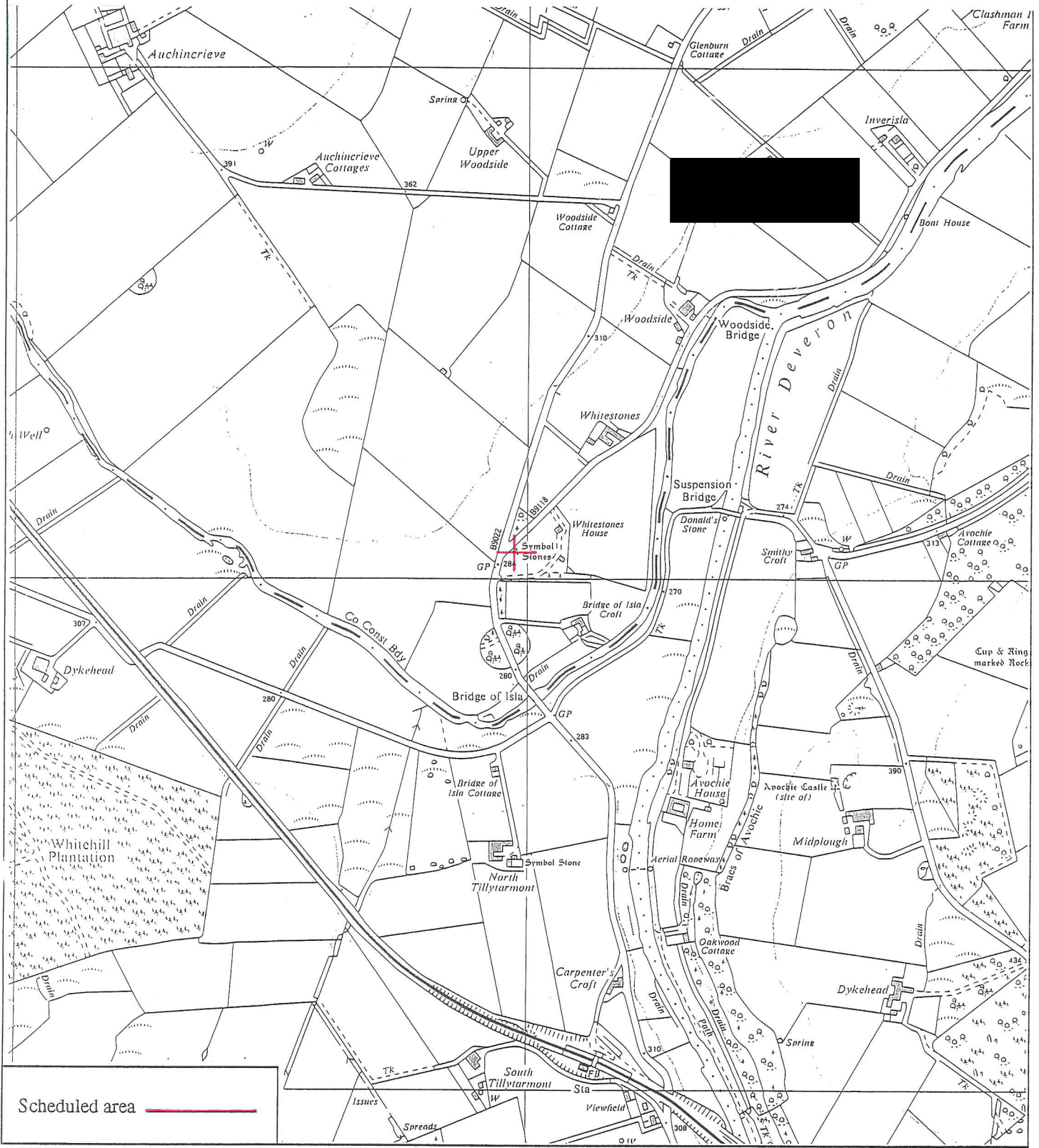




Whitestones House, three symbol

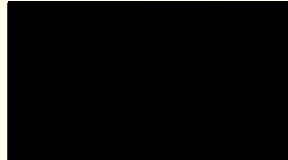
