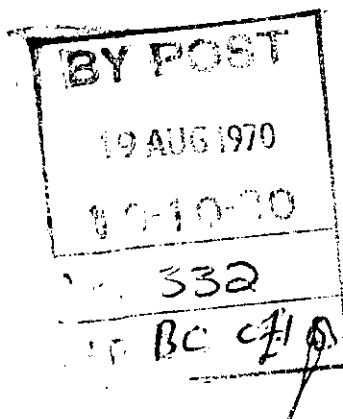

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931

Monument known as Mutiny Stones being a long cairn 278 feet in length, 76 feet wide at the eastern end and narrowing to 26 feet and varying in height from 11½ to 3 feet respectively with remains of chambers visible at the eastern end all as shown coloured red on the annexed plan and

situated in the Parish of Longformacus and
County of Berwick

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Scottish Royal Parks and Ancient Monuments) Order, 1969, the Secretary of State hereby gives notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

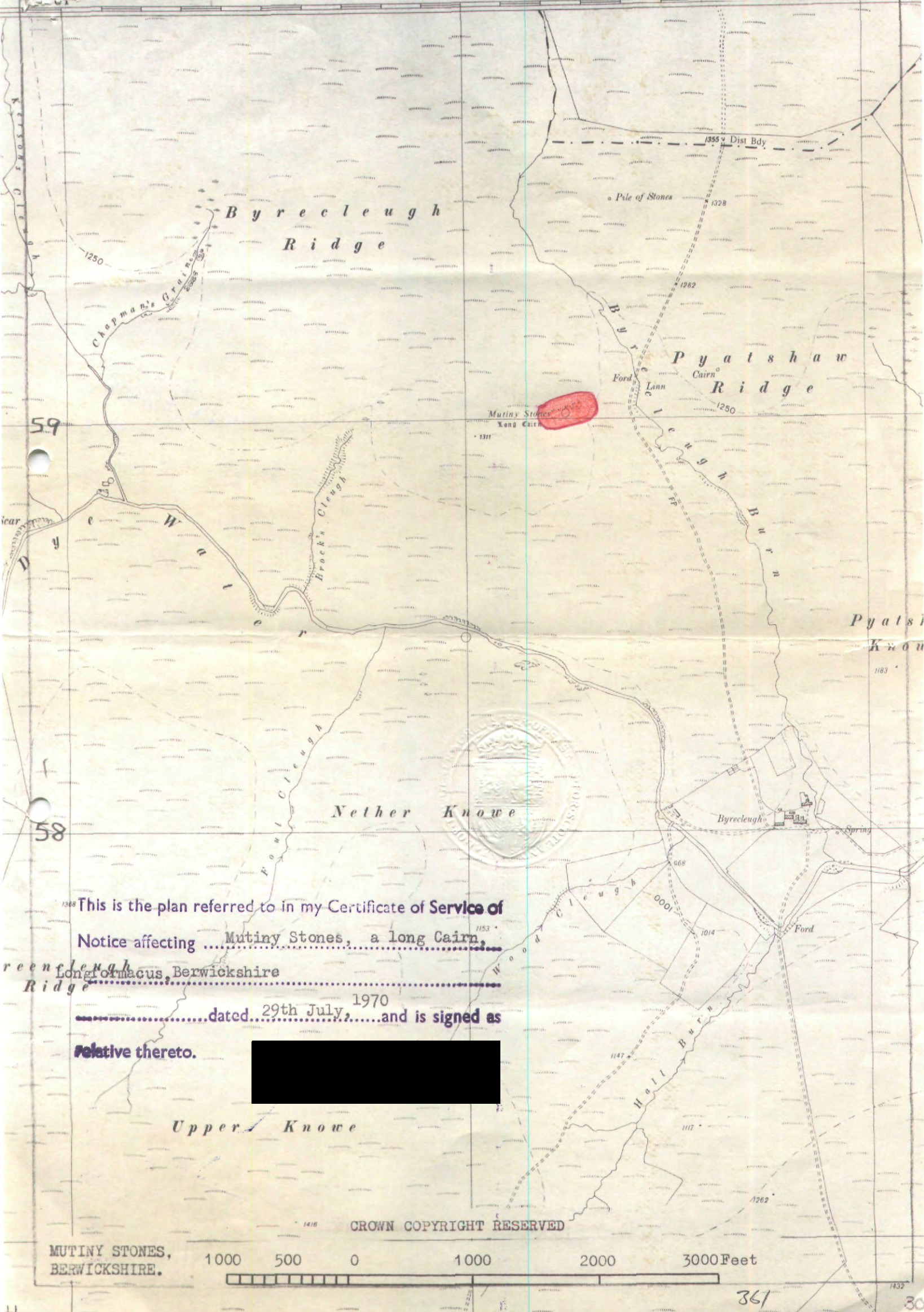
