The monument known as Giants' Graves, long cairns, Whiting Bay, Arran comprises two neolithic chambered long cairns of the Clyde Group, which are situated in a forestry clearing on the NE flank of Cnoc na Comhairle, overlooking Whiting Bay. The area to be scheduled measures 105m from NNW to SSE by 65m transversley, to include the cairns and an area around in which traces of evidence associated with their construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilbride and the County of Bute as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

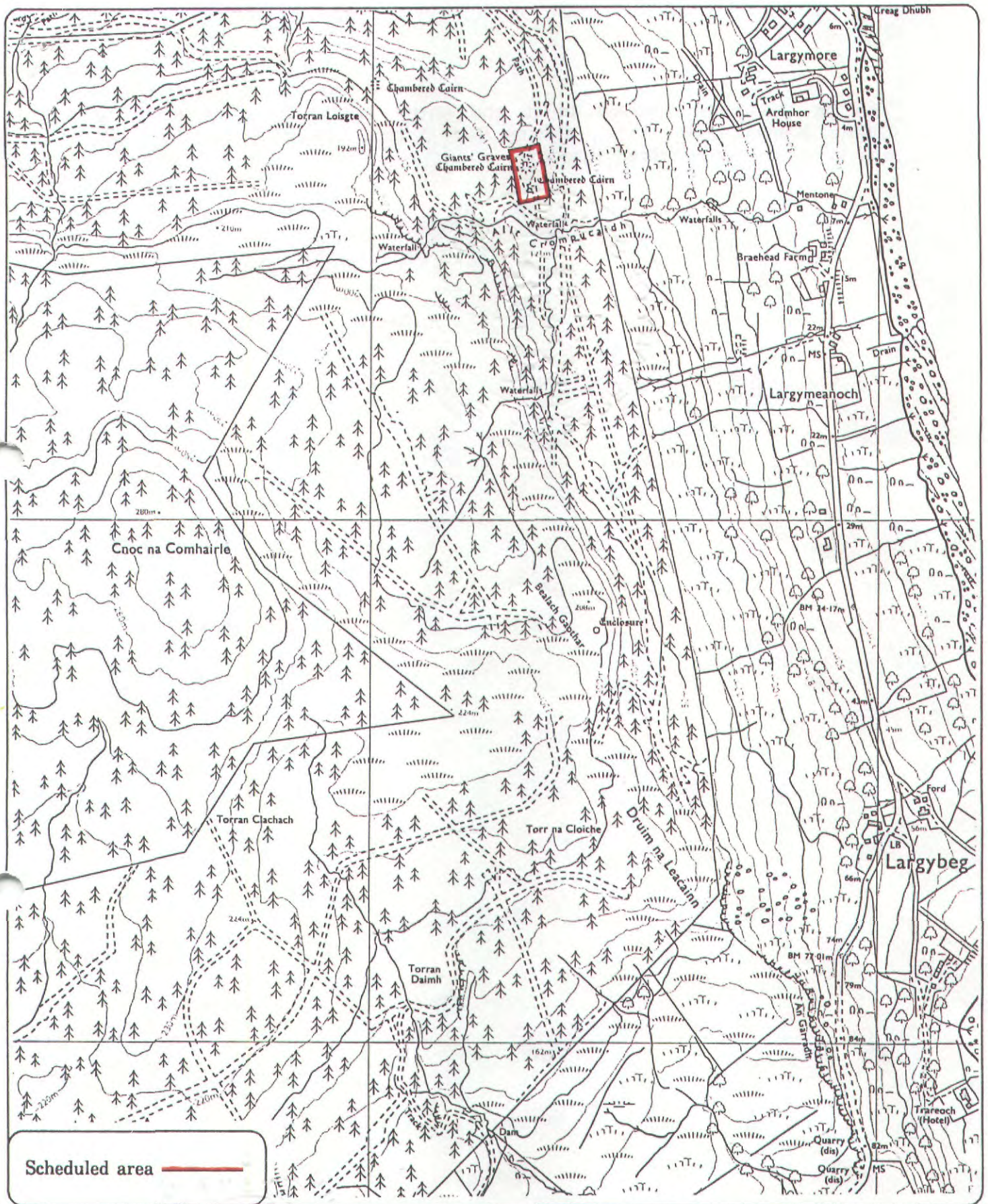

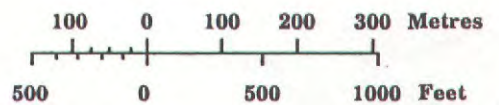

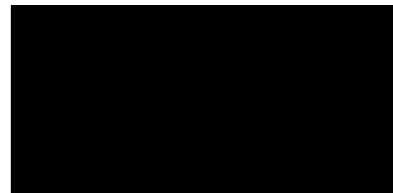
