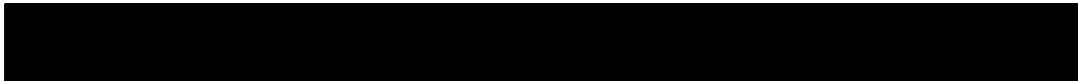

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.



the owner of the Monument known as Kingarth Standing Stones contained within an irregular area of ground having a maximum length from north west to south east of 40 yards and a maximum breadth from north east to south west of 10 yards, the south eastmost point of said area being situated 520 yards north west by north of the north west corner of the main block of farm buildings at Largizean, 550 yards east north east of the High Water Mark at its nearest point on the west shore of the Island of Bute to the south of Stravanan Bay, and 750 yards west by south of Bench Mark 54.0 on the north east gable of Gatehouse

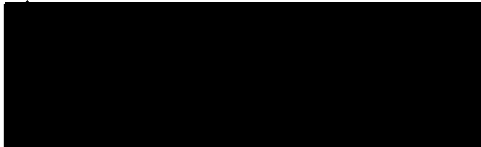
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as **The Bute Estate**

situated in the Parish of **Kingarth** and County of **Bute**.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

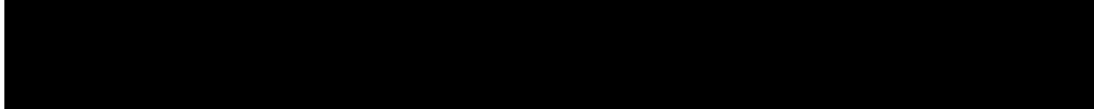

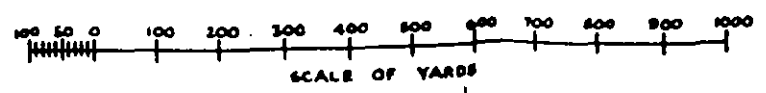
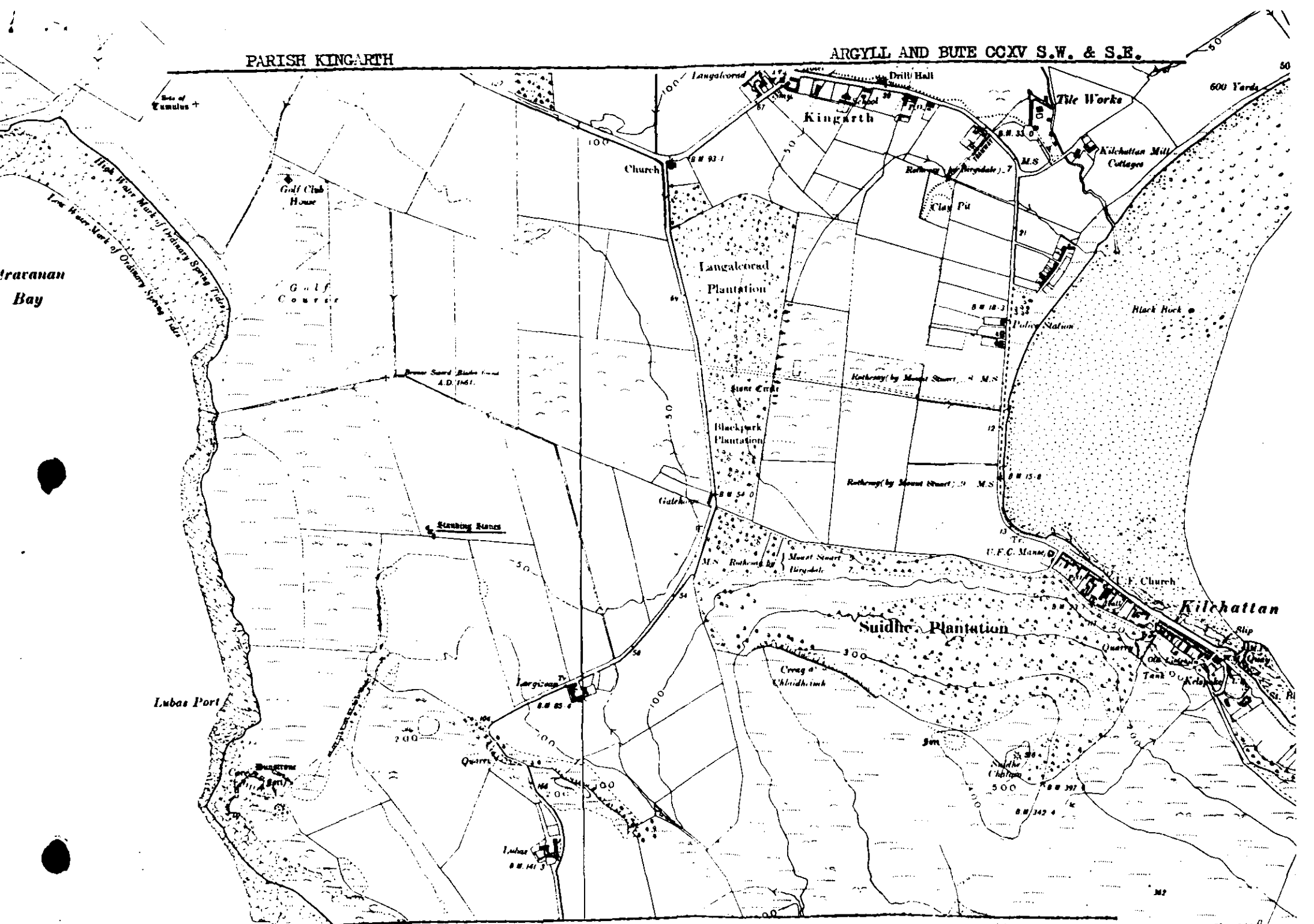
