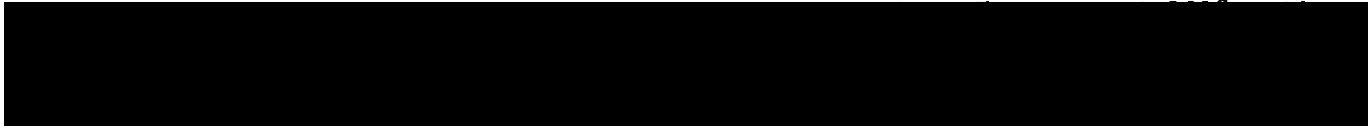

the owner of the Monument known as Monamor Segmented Cist or Cairn otherwise known as Meallach's Grave contained within a circular area of ground 100 feet in diameter, the northmost point of said area being situated 550 feet west north west of the Allt Lagriehek at its nearest point, 450 feet east at its nearest point of a burn flowing in a general north north east direction to the east of the Allt Domhain and 975 feet south by east of the junction of the said Allt Lagriehek and said burn,

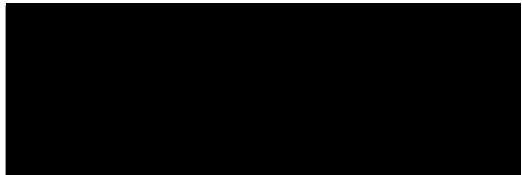
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as lands and Earldom of Arran

situated in the Parish of Kilbride and County of Bute.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
