the owners of the Monument known as King's Cave having a maximum depth of 118 feet from west to east and a maximum breadth of 44 feet from north to south situated on the west shore of Arran between Machrie Bay and Drumadoon Point the mouth of said cave being 20 yards above high water mark 1750 yards south-west by west of Crochandoon, 1890 yards west by north of Torbeg Smithy and 1530 yards west south-west of the Machrie-Blackwaterfoot road at its nearest point, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of

the property known as Farm of Drumadoon,

situated in the Parish of Kilmory and
County of Bute.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

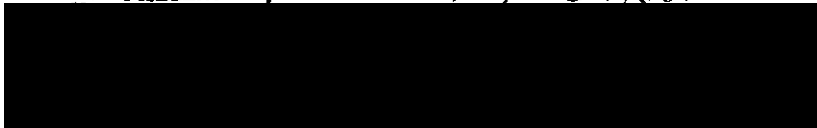
