being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as parts of the Lands and Estate of Latheronwheel

situated in the Parish of Latheron and County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby give you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
