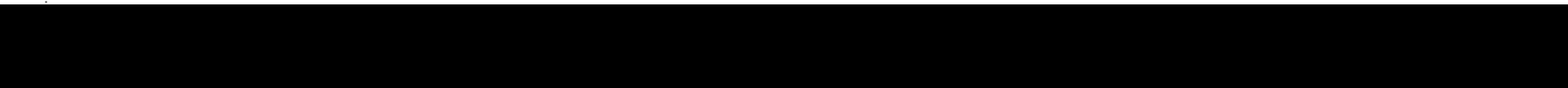

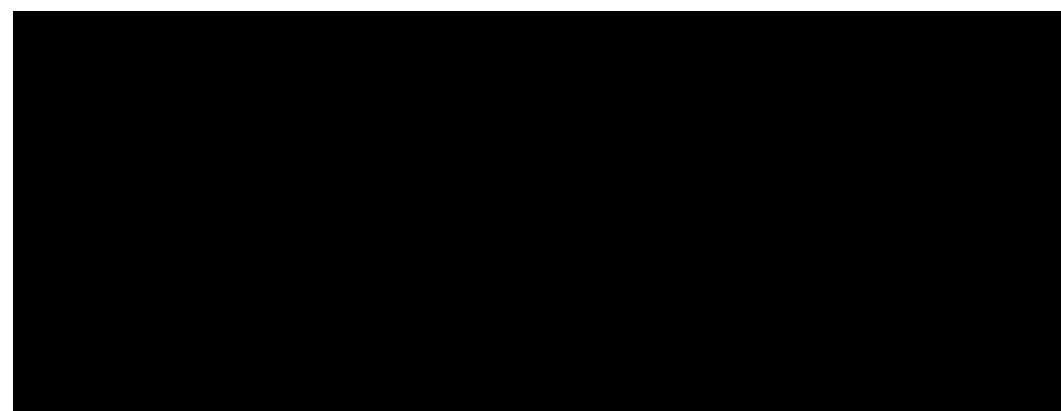
IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

 the owner
of the Monument known as Forse Castle (in ruins) occupying a
triangular area of ground immediately above high water mark on the
east shore of Caithness between North Gotten and West Gotten
measuring from its north-west point to its north-east point forty
yards in an east by north direction, from its north-east point to
its south point seventy yards in a south direction and from its
south point to its north-west point seventy yards in a north-north-
west direction, the north-west point of said area being situated
thirty yards north-north-east of said high water mark at its
nearest point at the head of West Gotten, seventy yards south-west
of said high water mark at its nearest point at the head of North
Gotten and nine hundred and sixty yards south-east by south of the
road between Wick and Dunbeath at its nearest point,
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of
the property known as Mains of Forse Crofts
situated in the Parish of Latheron and
County of Caithness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments
Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings
hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above
specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the
Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

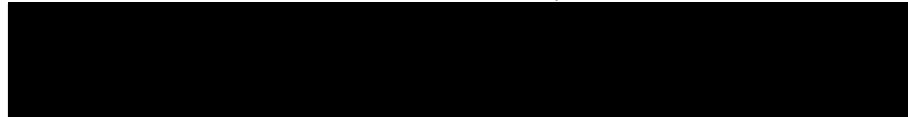
