Scheduled area

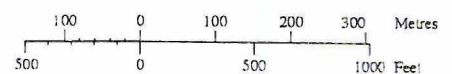
Castle Girnigoe and Castle Sinclair

THE COMMISSIONERS of HIS MAJESTY'S WORKS AND PUBLIC BUILDINGS as the Corporation confirmed by the Works and Public Buildings Act 1874 HEREBY CERTIFY that the ruined castle known as Castle Girnigoe, the outer ward of which is known as Castle Sinclair, situated on the peninsular strip of land jutting into Sinclair's Bay to the immediate west of Castle Haven, 900 yards west of Nosshead Lighthouse and 800 yards north-north-east of Ness being the subjects indicated in red colour on the plan annexed and signed as relative hereto and being part of the property known as Hempriggs Estate situated in the Parish of Wick and County of Caithness [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] is included in a list of Ancient Monuments prepared by them in pursuance of Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913 and published before the commencement of the Ancient Monuments Act 1931.
