the owner of the Monument known as "White Cairn" occupying an oval area of ground measuring 60 yards at its greatest length from north-north-east to south-south-west and 40 yards at its greatest width from west-north-west to east-south-east, the south-south-west most point of said area being situated 220 yards north of the Laurieston-Burnside road at its nearest point, 150 yards west by south at its nearest point of the track leading from said road to Fleuchlarg and 210 yards south-west of the south-westmost point of Fleuchlarg farm buildings

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Woodhead of Dardarroch

situated in the Parish of Glencairn and
County of Dumfries.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

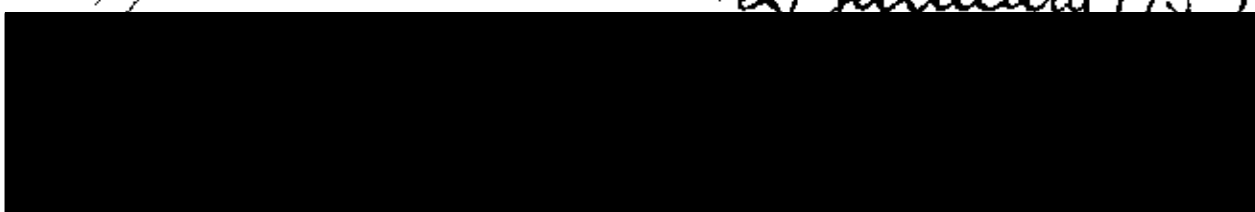
