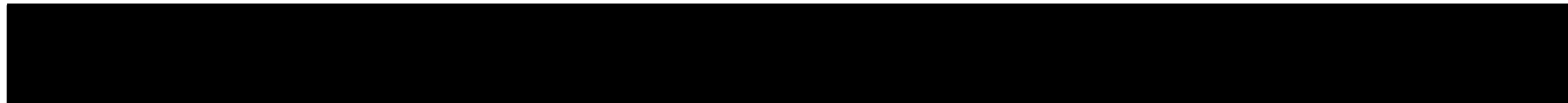

the owner of the Monument known as the Fort, occupying an oval area of ground on Carthur Hill measuring 110 yards at its greatest length from north-north-east to south-south-west and 70 yards at its greatest width from west-north-west to east-south-east, the north-eastmost point of said area being situated 200 yards west-north-west of the Dryfe Water at its nearest point, 310 yards south-west by west of the junction of said water with the Waterhead Burn and 470 yards north by west of the northmost point of the buildings at Dryfe Lodge

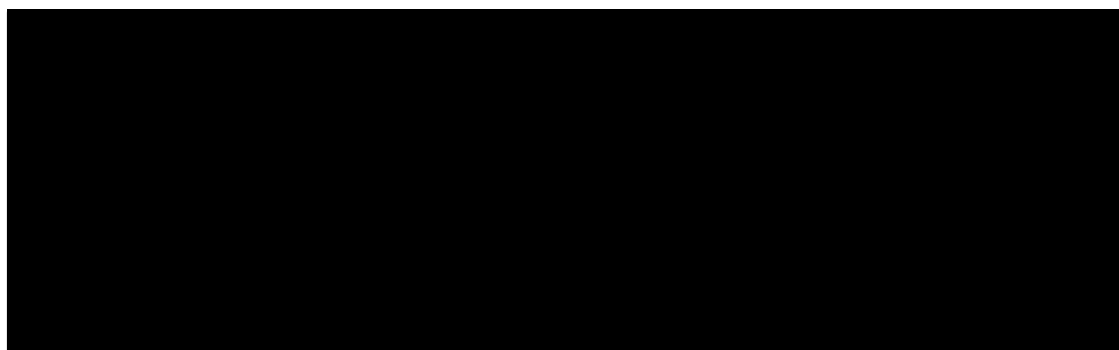
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Closs Farm

situated in the Parish of Hutton and Corrie and County of Dumfries.

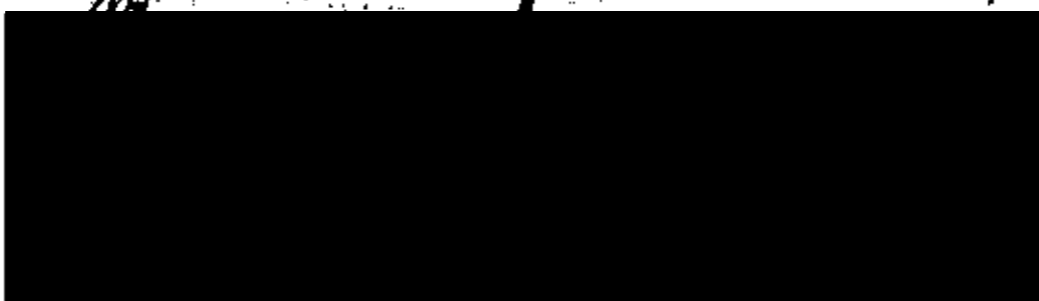
