the owners of the Monument known as Burnswark (Birrenswark) Hill consisting of Native Hill Fort, Roman South Camp and Fortlet, Roman North Camp, two Mediaeval Earthworks and a Seventeenth Century field work all contained within an irregular shaped area of ground (but excluding the small area of ground lying within said irregular shaped area of ground and not coloured on the plan aftermentioned)

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Burnswark Hill, Westgillmill and Park of Burnswark comprehended under the general denomination of Burnswark situated in the Parish of Hoddom and County of Dumfries.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

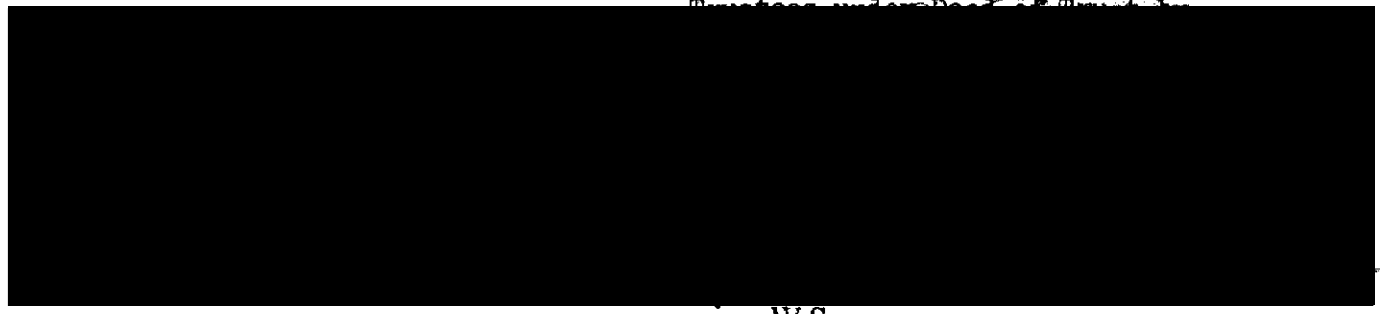
