ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Mote of Annan, motte-and-bailey castle, 70m SSW of Moat House comprises a motte-and-bailey castle dating to the 12th century AD. The monument is located between the W edge of the town of Annan and the E bank of the River Annan at 10m above sea level. This motte and bailey consists of a roughly circular earth and stone mound (the motte) up to 15m in diameter and 6m high. The bailey is separated from the motte by a ditch and extends south of it for 260m. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described and an area around within which evidence relating to the monument's construction and use may survive. The scheduling specifically excludes all walls, fences and other modern boundaries, as well as the top 300mm of all existing paths, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Annan and the County of Dumfries as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

[REDACTED], is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

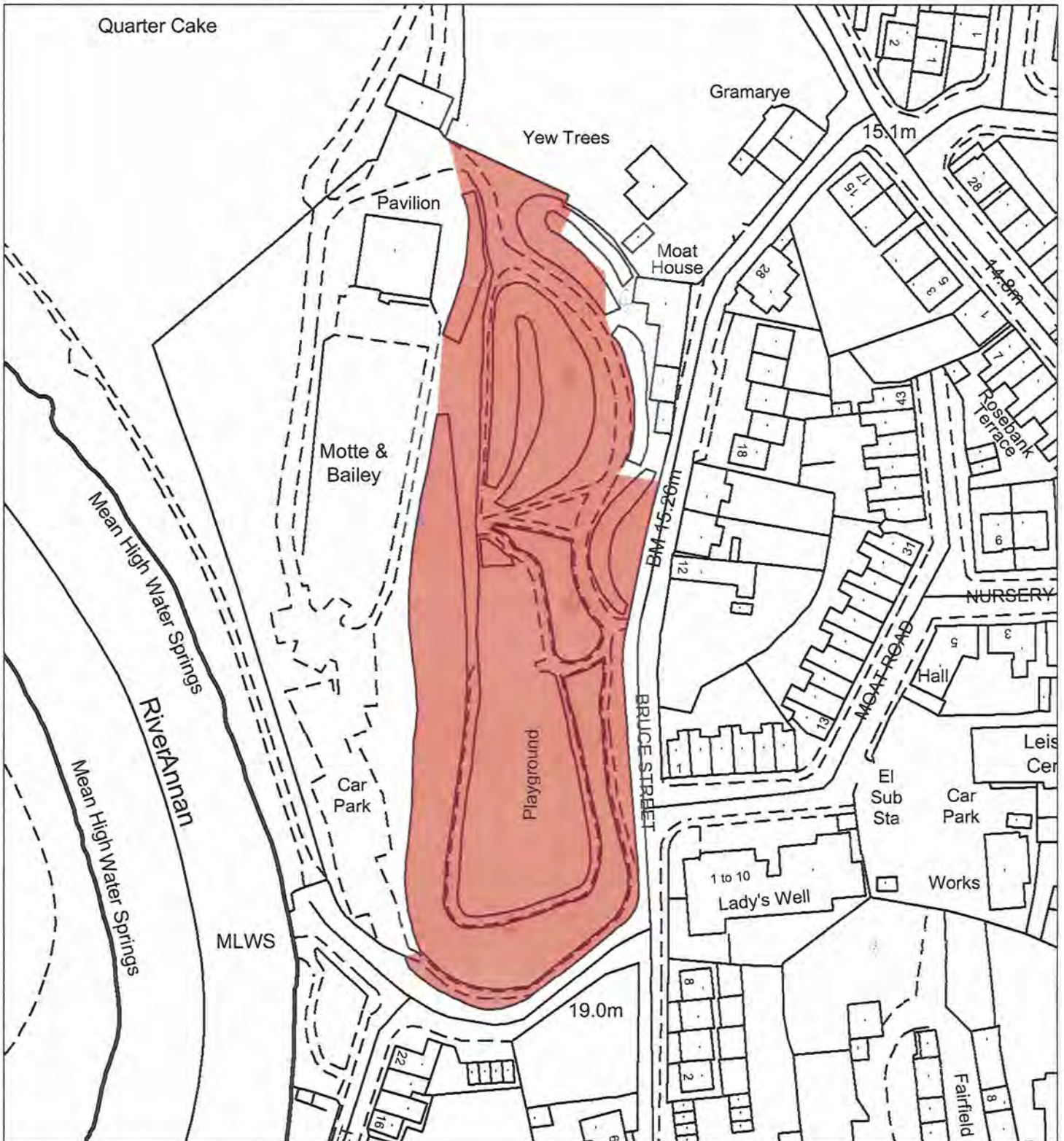

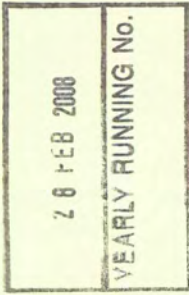
