the owners of the Monument known as Tibbers Castle (in ruins) and outworks occupying an irregular area of ground on Castle Bank and partly within Tibbers Castle Plantation measuring 210 yards at its greatest length from north by east to south by west and 70 yards at its greatest width from east by south to west by north, the northmost point of said area being situated 30 yards south-south-west of the Marr Burn at its nearest point, 120 yards west by north of the junction of the media filia of said Burn and the River Nith and 470 yards east by south at its nearest point of the drive leading northwards past Tibbers to Drumlanrig Castle,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm of Drumlanrig, Tibbers and others

situated in the Parish of Durisdeer and
County of Dumfries.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

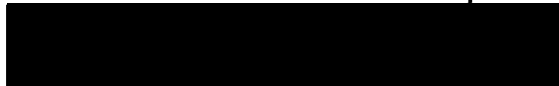




