IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

[redacted] owner or otherwise of the Monument known as Barnes Castle or "The Vaults" (in ruins) occupying a rectangular area of ground to the south-west of Athelstaneford, bounded on the north-north-west by the track leading in a general east-north-east direction from Barney Mains past Seaton Law Old Quarry to join the Haddington-Congleton Road to the south-west of Cogtail Bridge and measuring 200 feet on each of its north-north-west and south-south-east sides and 150 feet on each of its east-north-east and west-south-west sides, the northmost corner of said area being situated 220 yards south-south-east of the Cogtail Burn at its nearest point, 590 yards east-north-east of the north-eastmost corner of Barney Mains and 1080 yards west by south of the junction of said track with said road being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Farm of Barney mains on the Estate of Amisfield situated in the Parish of Haddington and County of East Lothian.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

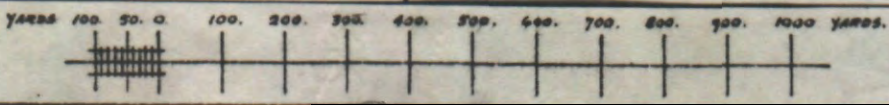
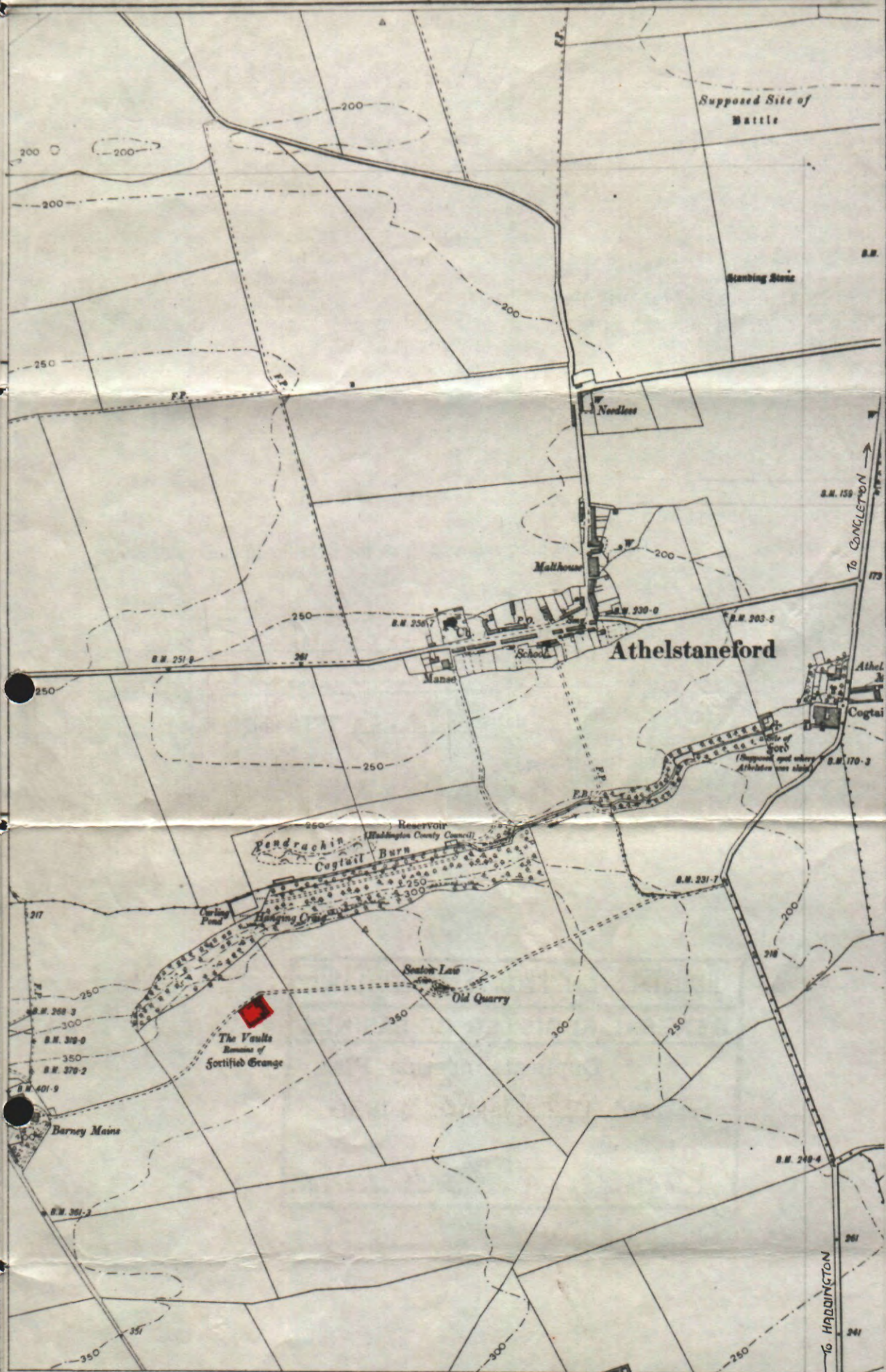
