IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 and 1931.

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[REDACTED] the owners of the Monument known as Innerwick Castle (in ruins) occupying an irregular area of ground on the west or left bank of the Thornton Burn measuring from its north-most point to its eastmost point 200 feet in a south-east direction, from its eastmost point to its southmost point 50 feet in a west by south direction, from its southmost point to its westmost point 190 feet in a west by north direction and from its westmost point to its northmost point 170 feet in a north-east direction, the northmost corner of said area being situated 230 yards north-east of the road from Innerwick to Thornton Bridge at its nearest point, 320 yards south by west of the road from Innerwick to Innerwick Station at its nearest point and 480 yards east by south of the junction of said roads being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the Lands, Lordship and Barony of Innerwick part of the property known as Biel and Dirleton Estates situated in the Parish of Innerwick and County of East Lothian.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
