may have as owners or otherwise of the Monument known as Abdie or Abbie Old Kirk (in ruins) situated within a graveyard 130 yards south-west by south at its nearest point of the Perth and Ladybank Branch of the North British Railway now the London and North Eastern Railway, 60 yards north of the north-west corner of Abdie Manse and 20 yards east by north at its nearest point of the track leading in a north-north-westerly direction from Abdie Manse to the modern church of Abdie being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Abdie Churchyard, situated in the Parish of Abdie and County of Fife.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

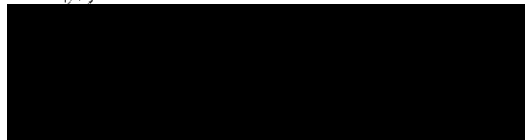
