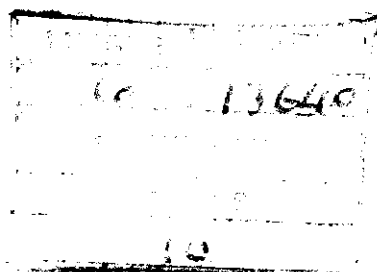

the owner of the Monument known as the Chapel (in ruins) and associated foundations contained within a rectangular area of ground on Chapelgreen, Earlsferry, measuring 135 feet on each of its north and south sides and 110 feet on each of its east and west sides, the north-east corner of said area being situated 25 yards west-south-west of the high water mark on the north shore of the Firth of Forth on the east side of the promontory at the west end of Earlsferry at its nearest point and 80 yards east-south-east of the south-east corner of the house or building known as Earlsneuk,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Commonty of the Royal Burgh of Elie and Earlsferry

situated in the Parish of Elie
County of Fife.
