ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Ballinbreich Castle, comprises a major courtyard castle which stands on sloping ground on the south shore of the River Tay. The area to be scheduled is irregular, measuring 92.5m from SSW to NNE and 67m from SSE to NNW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Flisk and the County of Fife as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects registered in the Land Register of Scotland under Title No FFE14230 (the present owner whereof being Robert Montgomery, Ballinbreich Farm, Newburgh, Cupar, Fife), is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

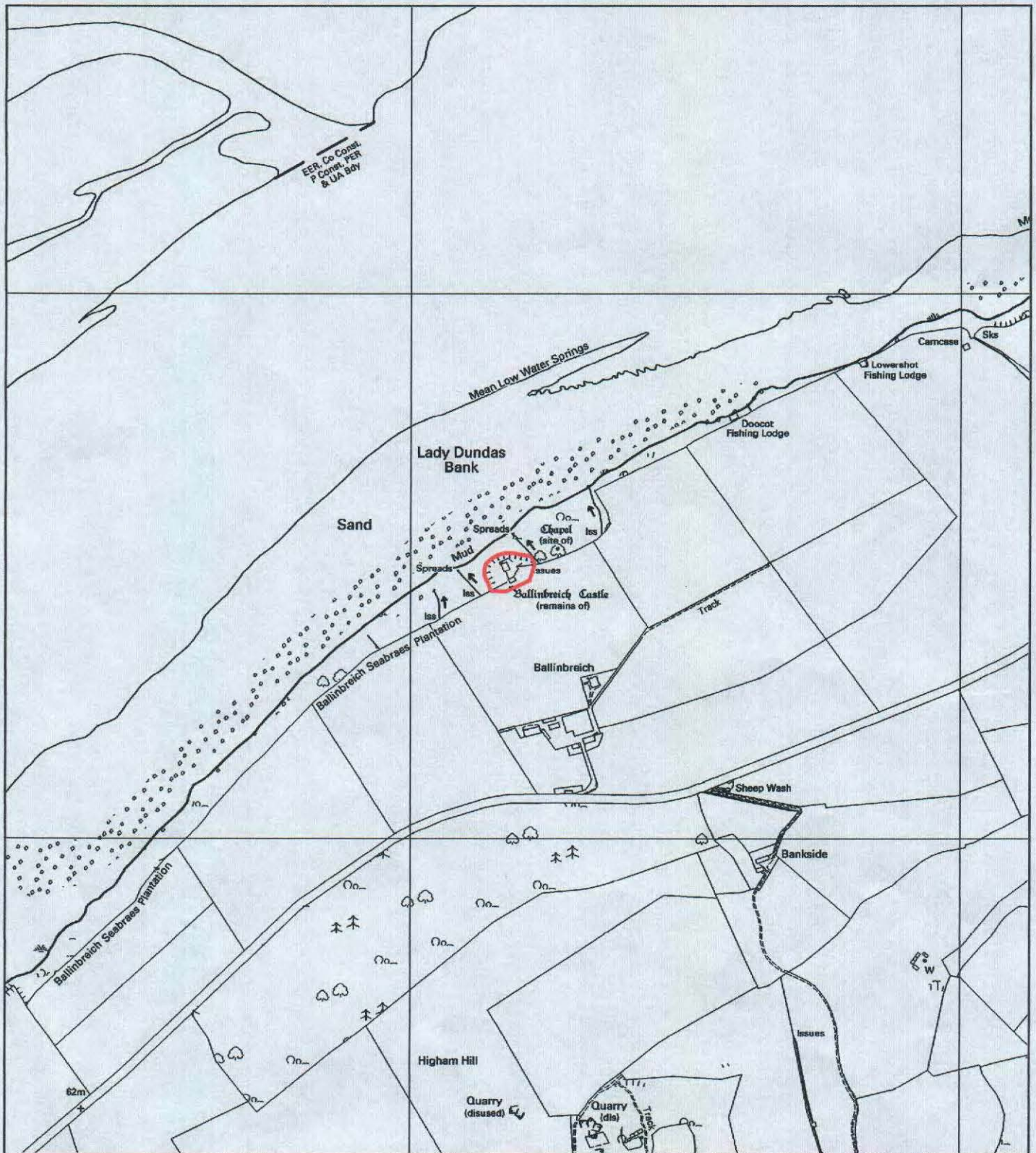

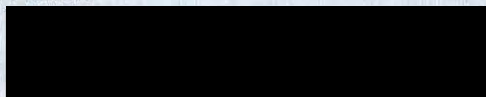
