[Redacted] the joint owners of the Monuments known as Denmylne Castle and Dovecot consisting of (First) the Castle situated immediately to the north-west of Denmylne Farm Steading, 35 feet north-east of the Newburgh-Auchtermuchty road at its nearest point and 80 feet north by west of the Bench Mark 93.8 on the westmost corner of said Farm Steading and (Second) the Dovecot situated on the north-east side of said road 16 feet south-west of said Castle and 60 feet north-west of said Bench Mark being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Denmylne Farm situated in the Parish of Abdie and County of Fife.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monuments above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
