The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Leuchars Castle, motte, dated 5 February 1954 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Fife on 19 February 1954 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 370m ENE-WSW by 380m NNW-SSE. All existing modern fences are excluded from this scheduling as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

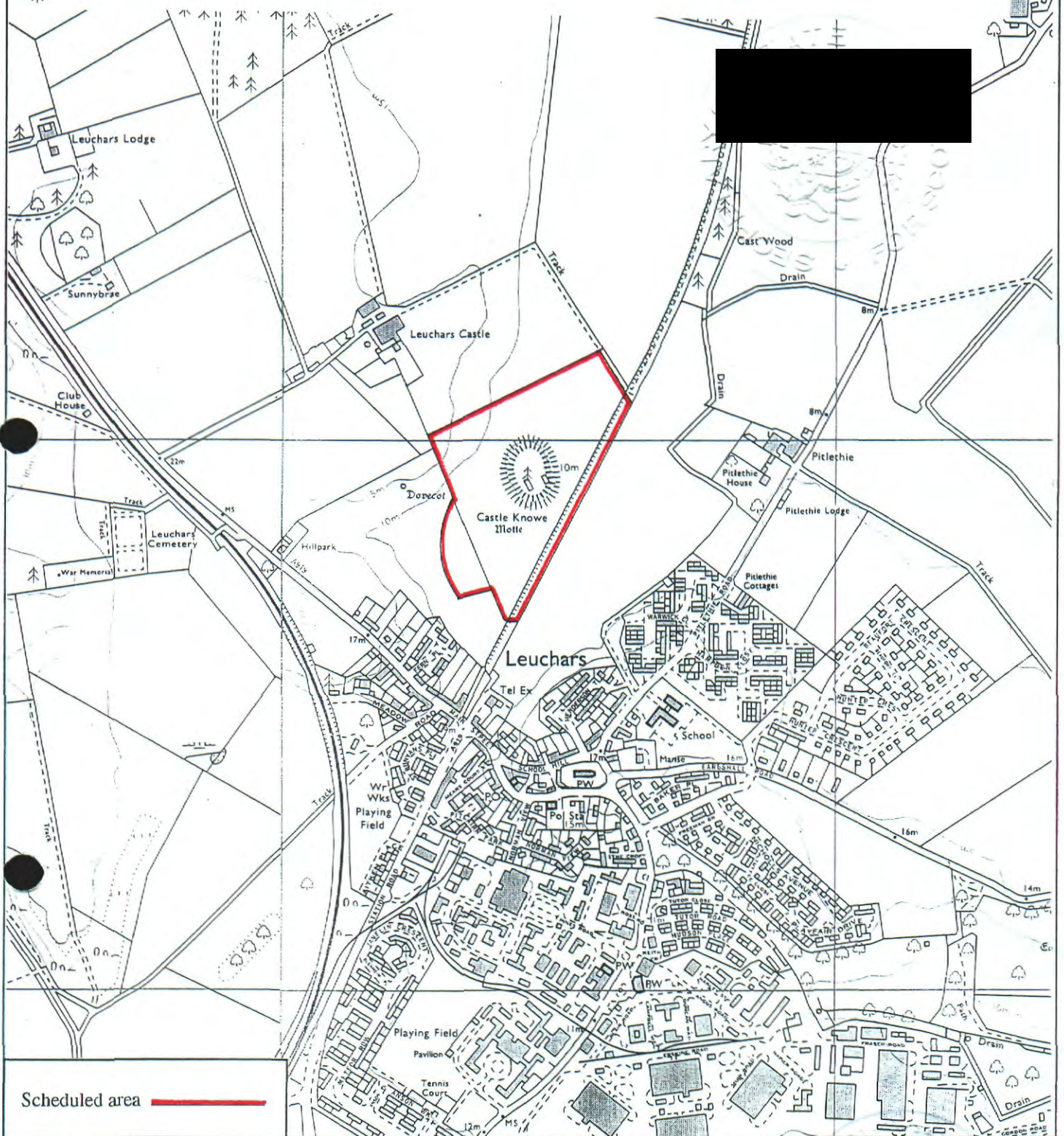

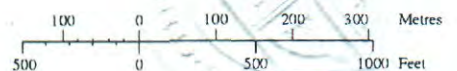
Leuchars Castle, motte and associated remains
