the owners of the Monument known as Lochore Castle (in ruins), occupying a circular area of ground 60 yards in diameter at Crosshill, 20 yards north-north-west of the River Ore at its nearest point, 230 yards west of the bridge carrying the road between Locheraig and Crosshill over said River and 30 yards south-south-west at its nearest point of the burn flowing east-south-east from Peveril Place to join said River to the west of said bridge,

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Lands of Lochore

situated in the Parish of Ballingry

and

County of Fife.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
