the owner of the Monument known as "Dun Cruinn" (fort) occupying an oval area of ground on the northermost of the three knolls known as the Skerinish Duns measuring 210 yards at its greatest length from north-north-west to south-south-east and 90 yards at its greatest width from east-north-east to west-south-west, the northmost point of said area being 270 yards east at its nearest point of the high water mark on the east shore of Loch Snizort Beag to the north of Rudha na h-Ollaig, 310 yards south-west by west at its nearest point of the high water mark on the south-west shore of Loch Eyre and 440 yards south by east of the northern extremity of Skerinish Quay being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of

the property known as Skerinish Farm

situated in the Parish of Snizort and County of Inverness

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

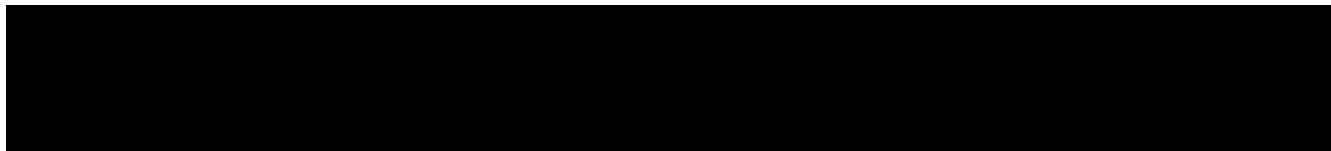

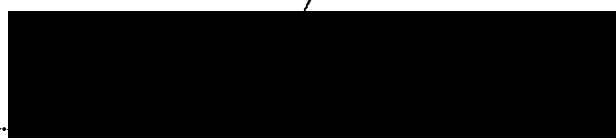
