The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Dun Flashader, broch, Skye, dated 13 September 1960 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Inverness on 30 September 1960 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as covering the whole of the top of the rock outcrop, with maximum dimensions of 50m NE-SW by 50m NW-SE as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

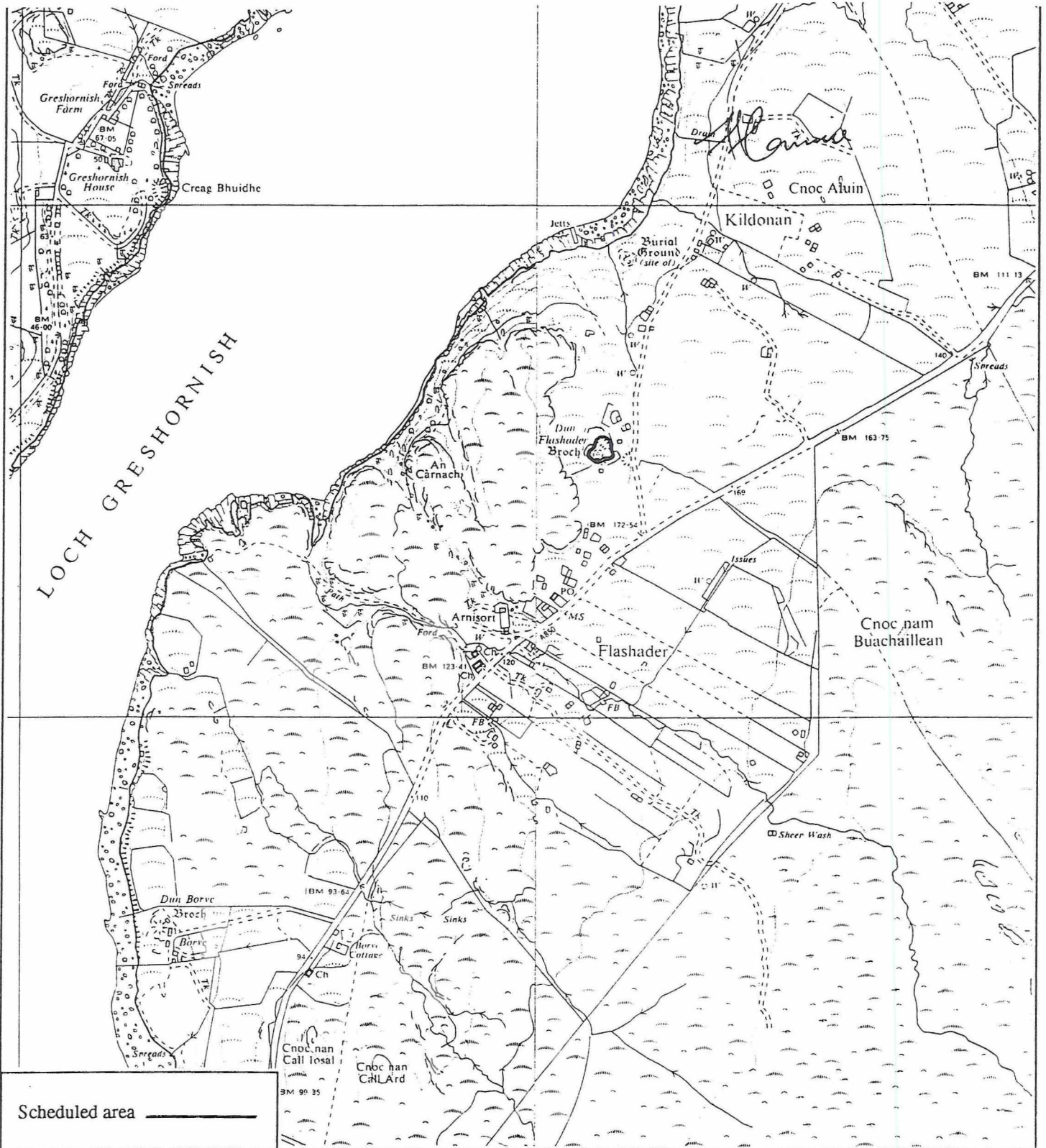

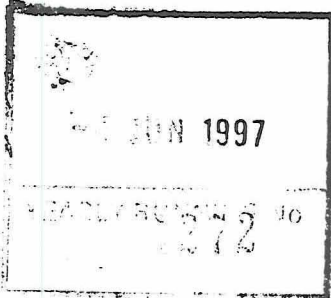

IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

To [redacted]

the owner of the monument known as Dun Flashader (Broch) contained within a circular area of ground measuring 60 feet in diameter the southmost point of said area being situated 570 feet north-west by north of the public road between Edinbane and Tayinloan at its nearest point; 1,140 feet south-east by east of the high water mark on the south-east shore of Loch Greshornish at its nearest point and 1,000 feet north by east of the milestone on said road two miles from Tayinloan

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Estate of Lynedale

situated in the Parish of Duirinish and County of Inverness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

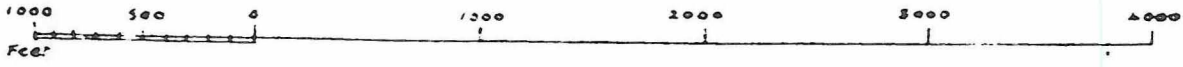
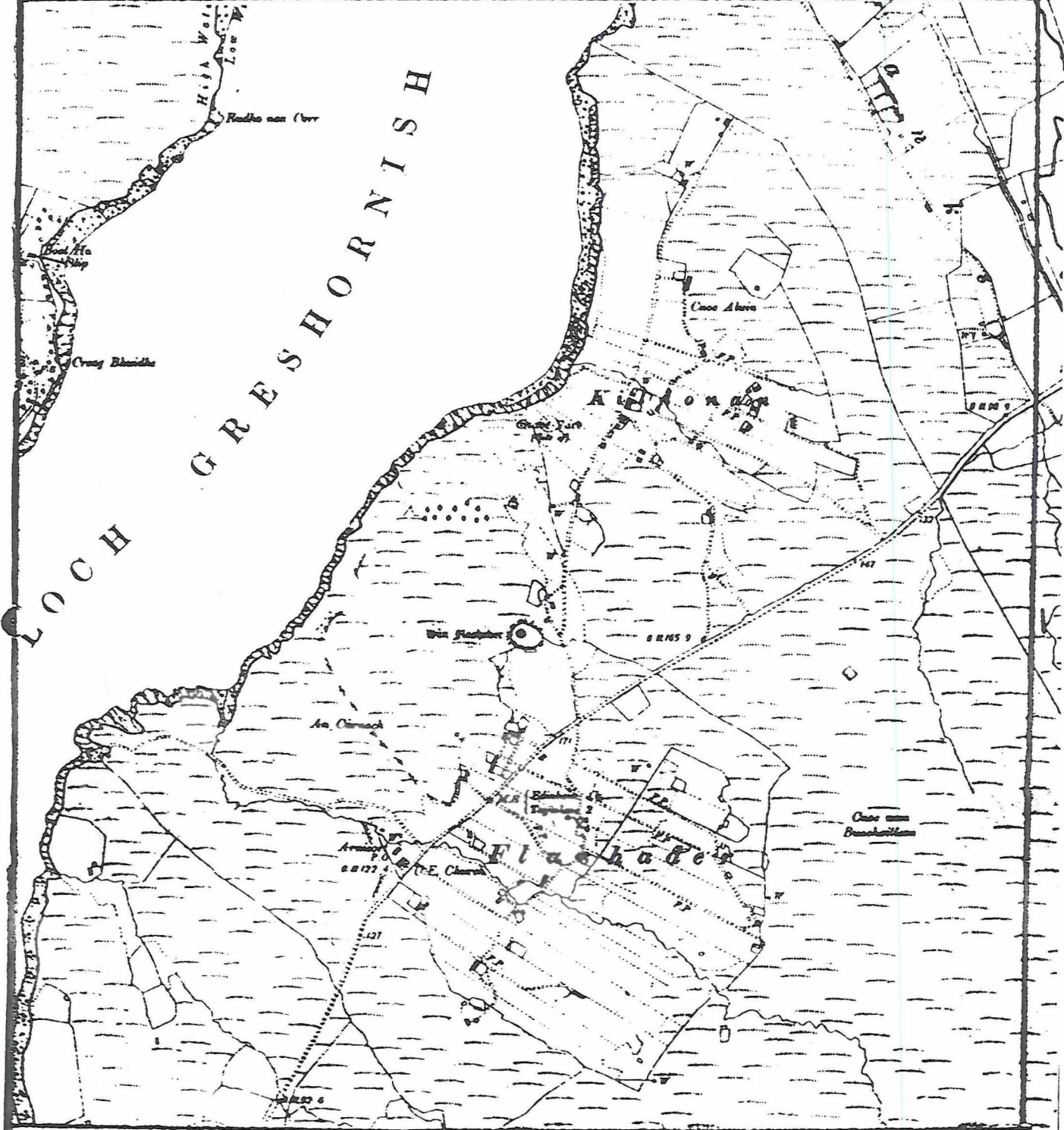
