the owners of the Monument known as Dun occupying an islet in the south east portion of Loch Hunder 200 yards south east of the Island of Dun Ban, connected on the south by a curved causeway 40 yards long with a small promontory on the eastern shore of said loch and on the north by a second causeway 20 yards long with a small adjacent islet lying 20 yards to the north east which small adjacent islet is connected with a small promontory 40 yards north of said first mentioned promontory by a third causeway 40 yards long together with said small adjacent islet and said three causeways being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Lee Farm situated in the Parish of North Uist and County of Inverness.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act 1913.

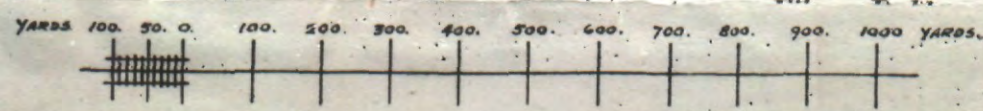
