


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979


The monument known as Balblair Stone, symbol stone, Moniak Castle Wineries, comprises an earthfast, upright carved stone bearing abstract and figurative carving which is prehistoric and early medieval in date. The stone is 1.3m high, 0.8m wide and 0.3m thick and displays the Pictish carving of a man apparently walking from left to right holding a staff or sword, as well as prehistoric cupmarks. It stands within a modern garden rockery immediately to the SW of Moniak Castle. The area to be scheduled is circular, centred on the stone, to include the remains as described. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kirkhill and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

Subscribed by Malcolm Cooper, Chief Inspector with Historic Scotland, being an officer of the Scottish Ministers at Edinburgh on the 9 day of March Two thousand and seven, before this witness Victoria Ball, of Longmore House, Salisbury Place, Edinburgh.

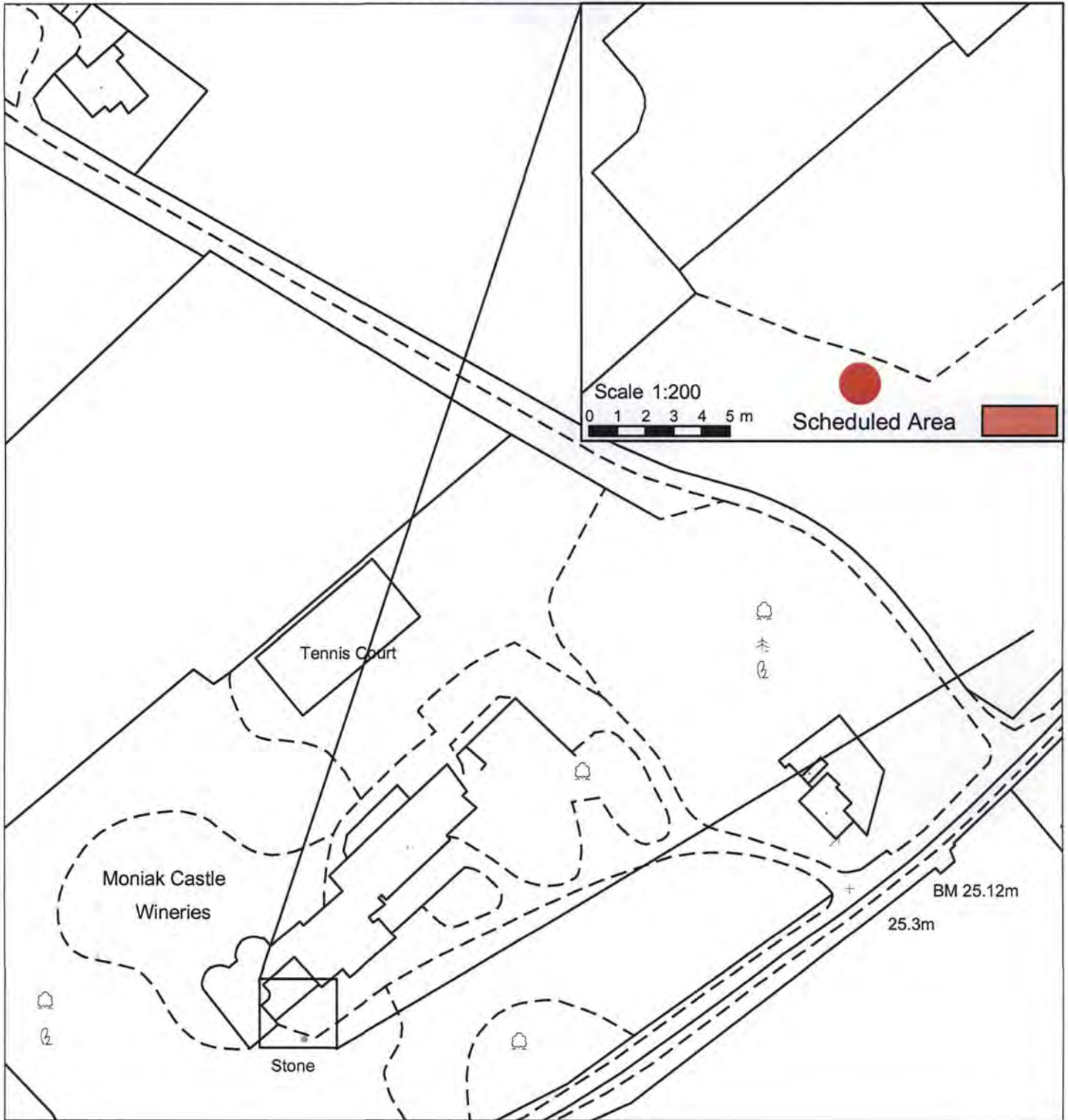
