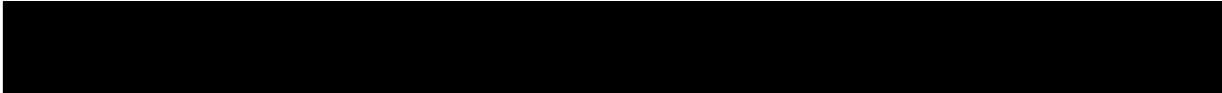

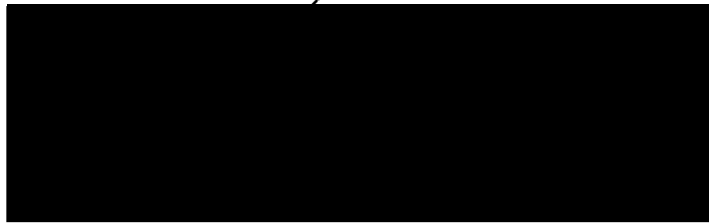

situated in the Parish of Snizort and County of Inverness.

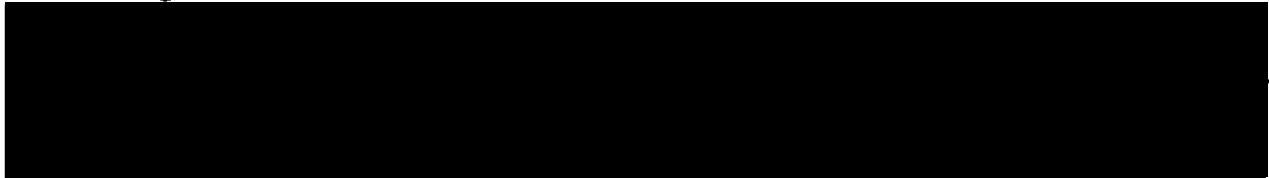
