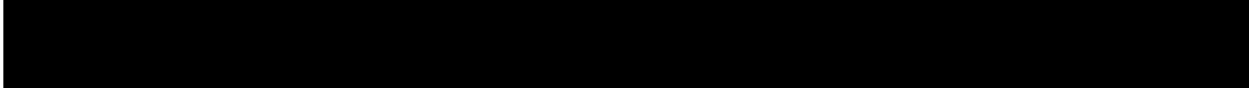

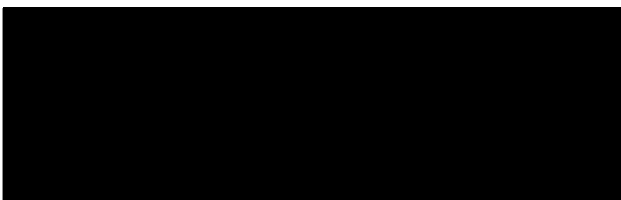
being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Estate of Skeabost

County of Inverness.


