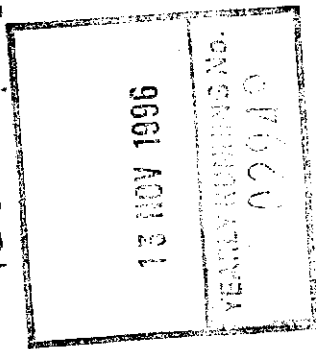

The monument known as Craighead, stone circle 70m NNE of Hilltop Lodge comprises the remains of a stone circle, now enclosed by a low stone wall. The area to be scheduled is a modern enclosure 10m in diameter. The enclosure wall is included in the scheduling. 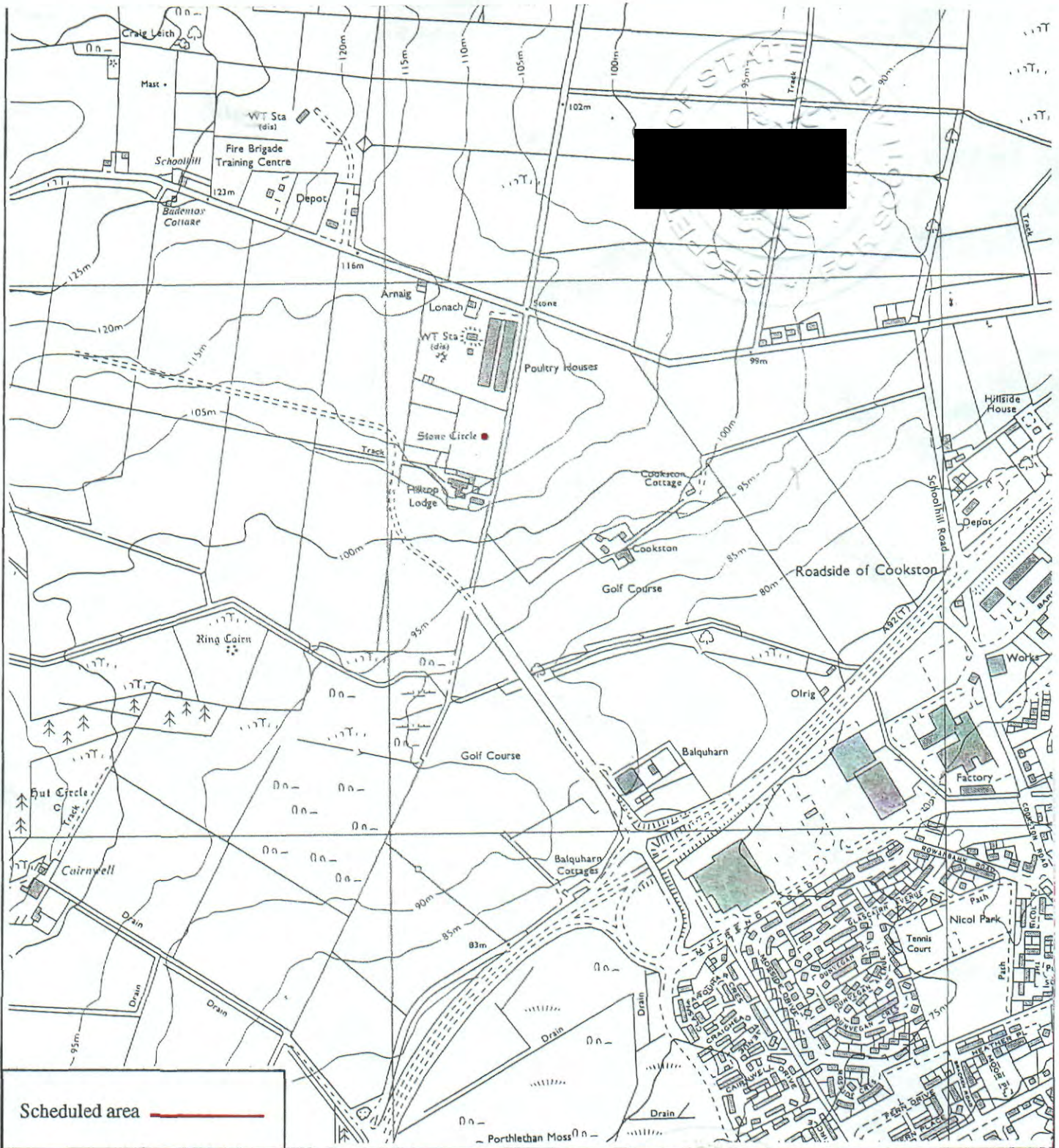
