IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

[REDACTED] the owner of the Monument known as the fort with cairn occupying an irregular area of ground on the summit of Dumglow, Cleish Hills, bounded on the north-west by the cliff on the north-west side of Dumglow along which it extends 320 yards measuring in a straight line from its north-eastmost point to its westmost point, on the south-west by the cliff on the south-west side of Dumglow along which it extends 330 yards measuring in a straight line from its westmost point to its south-eastmost point and on the east by open moorland on said summit along which it extends 300 yards from said south-eastmost point to said north-eastmost point, said southmost point being 160 yards north-east of the north-east shore of Black Loch at its nearest point, 740 yards north-west of the point where the boundary between the counties of Fife and Kinross crosses the north-west shore of Loch Glow and 280 yards north by west of the point where the burn flowing from Black Loch to Loch Glow leaves said first mentioned loch, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as Cleish Castle Estate situated in the parish of Cleish and County of Kinross.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

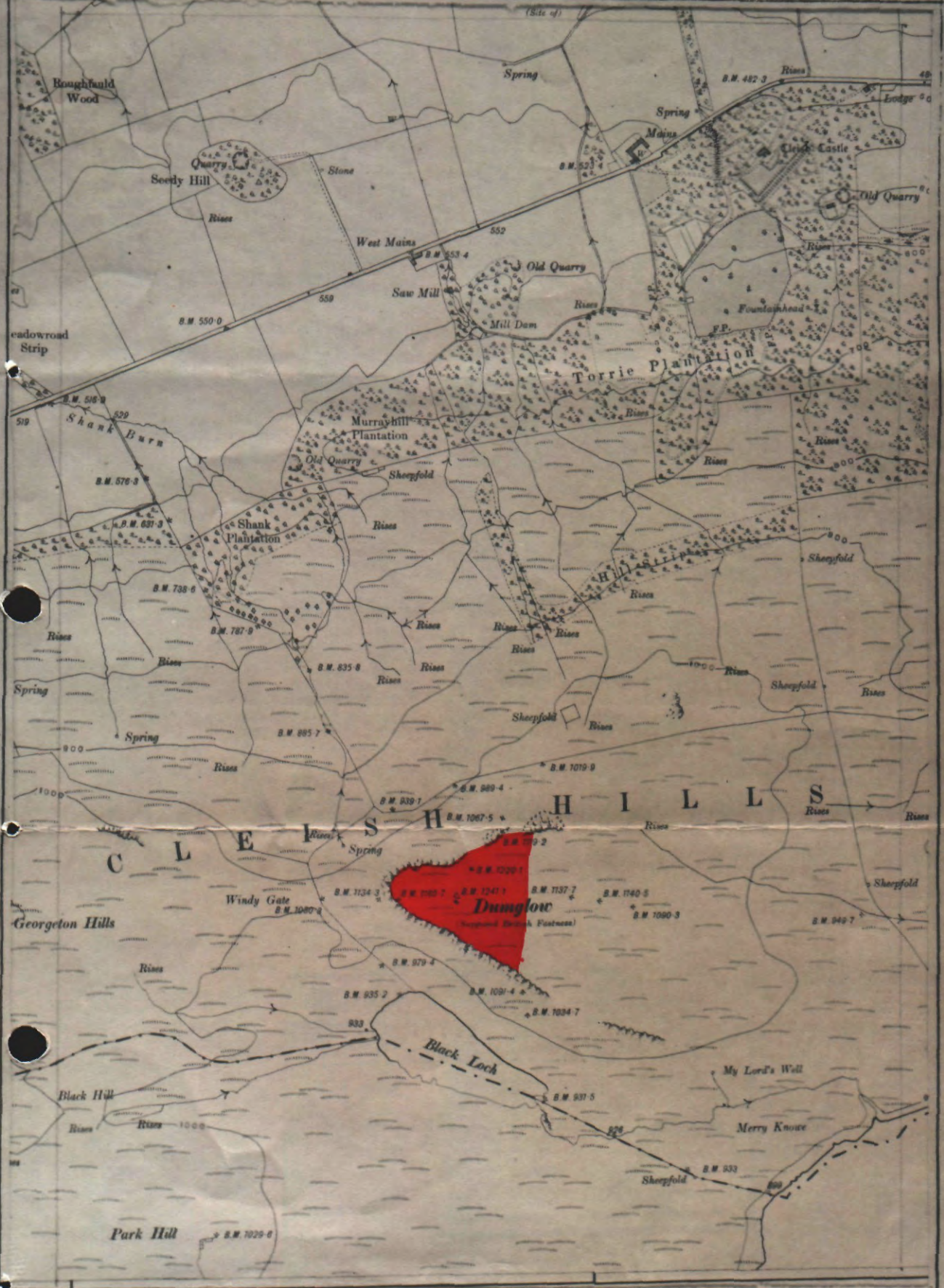
