the owners of the Monument known as Dowhill Castle (in ruins), bounded on the south and west by the wall or fence forming the boundary of the plantation immediately to the south of Barns, Cleish along which it extends 130 feet and 120 feet respectively and on the north and east by other parts of said plantation along which it extends 110 feet and 90 feet respectively, the south-west corner of said Castle being situated 220 yards south-west by south of the road between Barns and Rodgie at its nearest point, 550 yards west by north of the west gable of Rodgie and 500 yards north-north-east of the north-east corner of Flockhouse being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands of Dowhill and others situated in the Parish of Cleish and County of Kinross.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

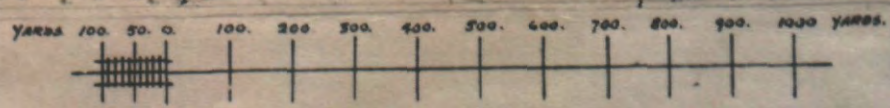
