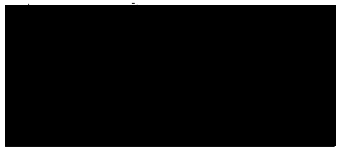
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

The monument known as Billy Diamond's Bridge, stone circle 300m SSE of, Glenquicken comprises of the remains of a stone circle of prehistoric date, set on the N side of Englishman's Burn. The area to be scheduled is circular, 40m in diameter centred on the central stone, to include the stone circle and an area around in which evidence for its construction and use may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kirkmabreck and the County of Stewartry of Kirkcudbright as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

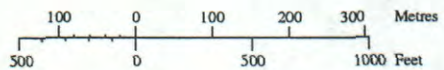
