IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

the owner of the Monument known as Dungarry Fort (or Camp) occupying an oval area of ground on Dungarry measuring 170 yards at its greatest length from east-south-east to west-north-west and 120 yards at its greatest width from north-north-east to south-south-west, the north-westmost point of said area being situated 290 yards north-east by north at its nearest point of a burn running eastward between Dungarry and the Knoits of Bentador to join the Colan Burn, 350 yards north-east by east of the bench mark 512.6 on the dyke running north-north-east from the hill between said Knoits and the Knoits of Linkins at the point where it crosses the track between Glenhead and Nether Linkins and 1130 yards south-east of the east gable of the south-most building at Nether Linkins being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of

the property known as the Farm of Nether Linkins or Linkins

situated in the Parish of Berwick or Herrick

and

County of the Stewartry of Kirkcudbright.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

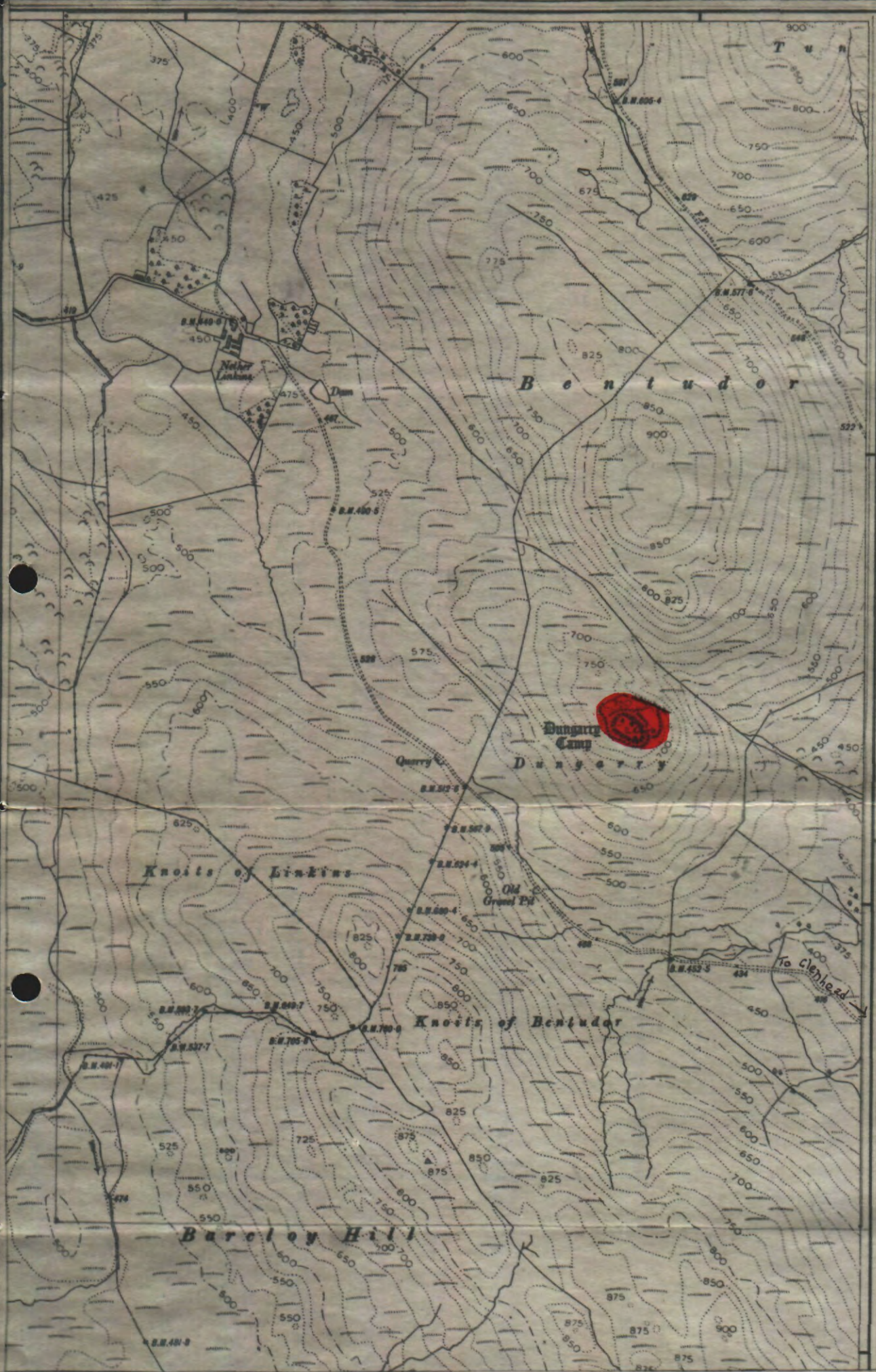
