for any interest he may have as owner or otherwise of the Monument known as Buittle Old Kirk (in ruins) consisting of (First) the Nave or westmost portion occupying a rectangular area of ground measuring 47 feet on each of its north and south sides and 22 feet 9 inches on each of its east and west sides and (Second) the Chancel or eastmost portion occupying a rectangular area of ground at the east end of said Nave measuring 35 feet on each of its north and south sides and 25 feet 9 inches on each of its east and west sides, the north eastmost point of said Kirk being situated 45 yards south by west of the south-eastmost point of the modern Kirk, 40 yards west by south at its nearest point of the road leading south from the Manse of Buittle past said modern Kirk and 175 yards east by north at its nearest point of the road leading south-south-east to Palmackie from the Castle Douglas-Dalbeattie Road being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the Estate of Munches situated in the Parish of Buittle and County of the Stewartry of Kirkcudbright.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Commissioners of His Majesty's Works and Public Buildings hereby give you notice that it is their intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by them under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

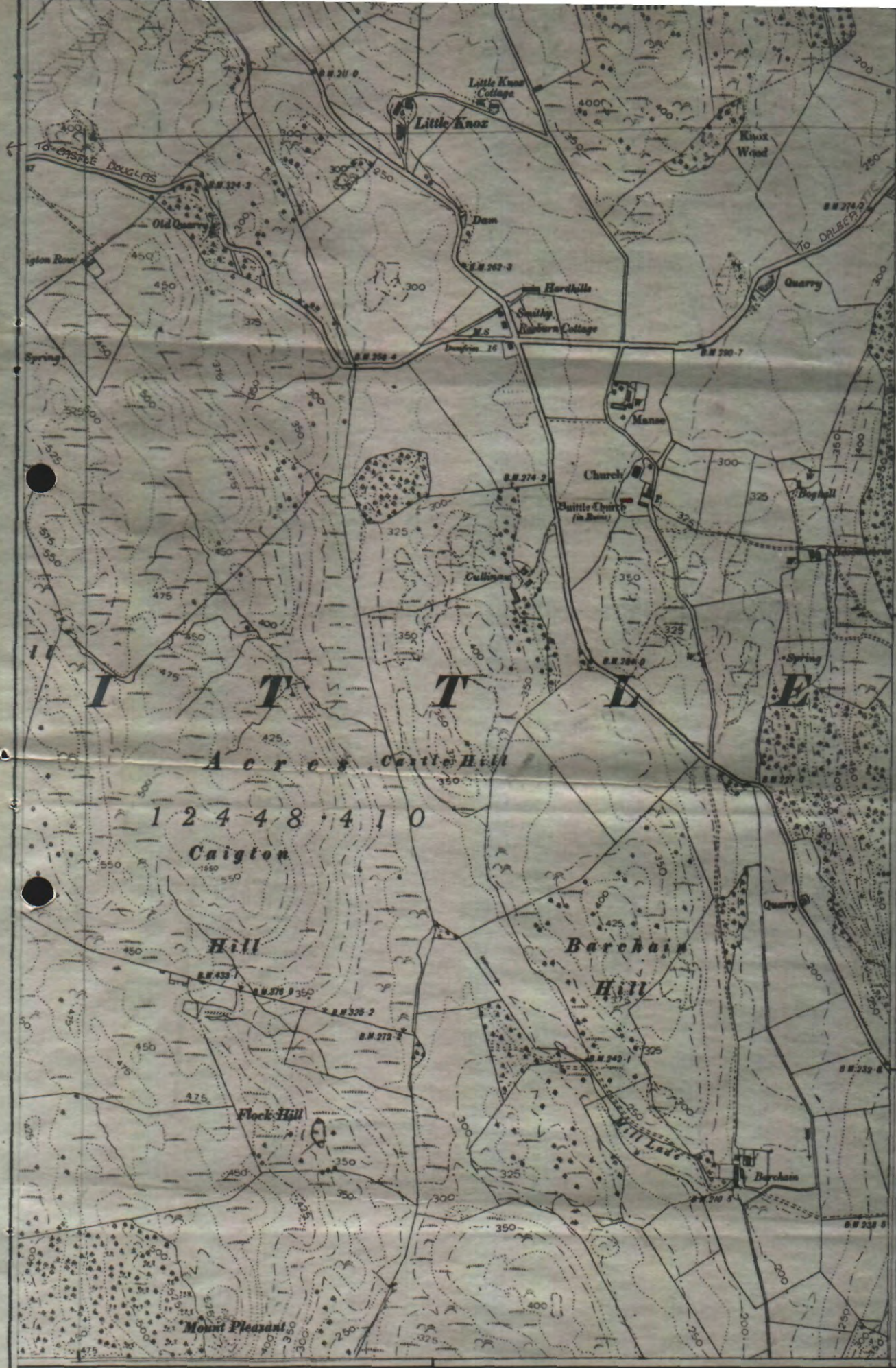
